Remarks on Board Bark C. W. Morgan

Tuesday Oct. 25th

Moderate breeze from N.W. in the first part with light rain. Squalls we saw the Island and steered S.E. in the latter part light breeze and pleasant at 3.40 P.M. we got in the harbor and lower boat and went shore and sent boat back at sun down with latter rain number vessels some to anchor and some off and I go off on in the passage with light breeze from N.

Wednesday Oct. 26th

This day begins light breeze from N.W. and calm the ship working trying to get in Fagat at last we lower boats and tow the vessel in and commence to break out oil we come to anchor at 9 A.M. and send home 133 Barrel of oil in the latter part fine breeze from W. at 5.40 P.M. the Captain come on Board and got under way and steered to South left the same day to anchor about 9 hours Discharged Coak Dick J. Harding

Thursday Oct. 27th

Light breeze from W. and Pleasant in first part we S. and S.E. saw number vessels in the latter part the same 5 of the Islands in sight

Friday Oct. 28th

Light and pleasant breeze from W. in the first part of the day in latter part the same the Island in sight until 3 P.M. we sawolpher bottom and ship steered S.E. all day at Sando on took in light sails

Saturday Oct. 29th

Light breeze from N.W. in the first part of the day and Bark steering S.E. in the latter part we steered S.E. under small sails and the employed in setting up shoo ks

Sunday Oct. 30th

Light breeze from N.E. in the first part the Bark steering S.E. we made all sails in the latter part steered S.E. with wind about the same Lat. 34-51 North

Monday Oct. 31st

This day begins with calm in the first part middle part light air from N. Saw black fish lower and got one got four turtle and got Barrel of the rosin oil and breeze strong from W.S.W. and then S.W. to S.E. and Bark heading about S.E. by the wind

Tuesday Nov. 1st

Fresh breeze and Squally weather from S.W. Bark steered S.E. in the first part in the latter part wind from W.S.W. and clear Bark steered by the wind heading about S. with fore top gallant sail out Lat. 33-35 North

Wednesday Nov. 2^d

Light breeze from S.W. and pleasant in the first part Bark heading by the wind Saw two merchant men heading N.W. and saw number been backs in the latter part the same saw two vessels and wind S.W. Lat. 31-55 North

Thursday Nov. 3^d

Fine breeze from S.E.W. all this day and number ships in sight and saw and Canary Island in sight and crew employed in filling water
