Remarks on Board C. W. Morgan of

Monday Nov. 28th

Strong breeze from N. to N.E. and
rugged in the first part of the day
the Island in sight in the latter
part moderate we made Sails and
head for Fogo wind from E. and
we head N. Blaw on Sloop

Tuesday Nov. 29th

This day begins with calm in the
first part of the day in the latter
part moderate breeze from N.E. and
clear weather Barge Steered N.W.
by N. went by Fogo at about
10.30 P.M. with double reefed for
top sail and whole main top
sail

Wednesday Nov. 30th

Strong breeze from N.E. all most gale
we raised the Island of Brava and la-
pe off for her we got down to the Is-
land but weather so bad we could
not lower a Boat made back off
lame Back at about 10 P.M. made one
attempt to lower as soon boat was
hoisted David Brake and two men
over Board we lost Fourth Mate
we lower west Boat but he was g-
ne we spoke one vessel we call her
Marmiel and we lost Starboard boat seven
one man

Thursday Dec. 1st

Strong breeze from N.E. in the first
part of the day we took down fore sail
to be repaired in the latter part
moderate land about 10 miles at
2 P.M. we stood off all the rest of the
day until night

day at 9.30 A.M. we lower Boat and

Saturday Dec. 3rd

Light breeze from N.E. and quiet
smooth we wor ship and heading to
the land under small Sails we bro-
ke out water in the latter part the
same light breeze and smooth we
Blaw Blaw oil that we had on
the deck about 45 Barrels of oil

Sunday December 4th

Light breeze and moderate in the first
part of the day two vessels in sight and
the Island in the latter part the same
at 4 P.M. we wor ship and head off
from land heading about N.

Monday Dec. 5th

Light breeze and quiet moderate
at 8.0 A.M. we lower Boat and
Captain went on shore in the latter
part Strong breeze and Captain come
back at 5.30 P.M. and lost three
men one vessels in sight and we
shipped two men

Tuesday Dec. 6th

Strong breeze and cloudy in the first
part of the day closed to the Island
at 8 A.M. lower Boat and Mate
went on shore in the latter part
moderate and Boat come back at
4 P.M. with the same crew we broke
fourd and stood off land 4 miles
