Remarks on Board Bark. C. W. Morgan.

Wednesday Dec. 28th

Strong breeze from S.E. in the first part of the day Barque steering by the wind heading about S. & S. by E. at 1 P.M. took in fore top gallant sail & goft top sail in the latter part more moderate the heading about the same we Brake out water

Lat. 13-30 South Long.

Thursday Dec. 29th

This day Commences with fine breeze and clear The Barque heading about S. in the first part of the day at 7.30 Saw white water but didn't mount to any thing in the latter part light breeze Saw one vessel heading to North

Lat. 15-58 South Long 30-29

Friday Dec. 30th

Light breeze from S.E. & S. in the first part of the day middle and latter part calm & cloudy weather by times Barque steered by the wind heading about S. by E. The crew employed in setting up riggin

Lat. 17-04 South

Saturday Dec. 31st

Fine breeze and Pleasant in the first part of the day Barque steering by the wind heading about S. by E. in the latter part the same the crew employed in setting up riggin we saw two merchant vessels one going north and the other South we saw plenty of Birds

Sunday Jan. 1st

This Commences with fine breeze from N.E. and pleasant the Barque steering S. at 4 A.M. Raised the Island of Trinidad and Morton was run down by them at 11 A.M. we are close by at 1 P.M. our Lat. was 20-32 South 1 mile to the S. of the Island in the latter part more pleasant and weather very fine we steered S.E. with all sails out but propus saw white water run for it but didn't mount to nothing

Monday Jan. 2^d

Fine breeze from N.E. and Pleasant in the first part of the day Barque steering S.E. with all sails out in the latter part the same Lat. about 23-00 South

Tuesday Jan. 3^d

Light breeze from N.E. in the first part of the day and pleasant Barque steering S.E. we sheaft water and creamed ship and maindial main top gallant sail Lat. 24-13 South

Wednesday Jan. 4th

Light breeze from N.E. in the first part of the day Barque steering S.E. but in the latter part wind from N.N.E. we repaired fore top sail and saw one vessel

Thursday Jan. 5th

Fine breeze and pleasant in the first part of the day the Barque steering S.E. Saw number vessels in the latter part the same steered S. by E. Spoke merchant man English Barque bound north and we are all employed at work painting and setting riggin
