Monday Jan. 16th

Strong breeze from S. in the first part of the day. Barque steering by the wind heading about E.S.E. in the latter part moderate at 130 P.M. wore ship and head S.S.W. wind S.E. and weather very cloudy

Tuesday Jan. 17th

Fresh breeze from W.W. in the first part of the day. Barque steered S.E. middle part light breeze from S. Barque steers by the wind heading about E.S.E. in the latter part Calm

Lat. 35-09 Long. 3-22 W.

Wednesday Jan. 18th

Light breeze and variable all this day. Barque steering S.E. and then S.E. by E. at Sundown all most Calm

Lat. 35-11 Long. 1-45 W.

Thursday Jan. 19th

Fresh breeze from N.E. in the first part of the day middle and latter part strong breeze from N. to N.W. Barque steered from S.E. to S.E. by S. the weather is very cloudy double fore top sail and took in fore top gallant sail

Lat. 36-18 S. Long. 1-16 E.

Friday Jan. 20th

Strong breeze from N.N.W. in the first part of the day Barque steering S.E. by S. under double reef fore top sail and main top gallant sail the weather very thick and rugged in the latter part the same at Sundown the wind hauled to W. and moderated. Saw number been Backs Lat. 37-40 S Long. 4-40 E.

Saturday Jan. 21st

Fresh breeze from S.W. in the first part the Barque steering S.E. by S. middle and latter part more moderate. Saw school Black fish at 5 P.M. Saw vessel whaler run for her and found to be Ship Niger garmed untill 11 P.M. and Broke up she had 3630 lbs. of oil 4 1/2 month

Lat. 38-19 S Long. 7-40 E.

Sunday Jan. 22nd

This day commences with and light air in the first part of the day in the latter part fresh breeze from E. Barque heading S.E. by E. Saw one vessel we suppose to be whaler did not speak her

Lat. 38-20 S Long. 9-11 E.

Monday Jan. 23rd

This day commences with fresh breeze from E.N.E. Barque heading about S.E. and S.W. middle part light breeze and fog squalls in the latter part fine breeze and wind hauled to N.E. Barque steered S.E. by E.

Lat. 39-09 Long. 10-49 E.

Tuesday Jan. 24th

Moderate Breeze from N.E. and rugged in the first part of the day middle part rainy and with hauled to N.W. Barque steered S.E. by E. in the latter part more moderate at 650 P.M. we saw spots but we did not find them out being so late we come to by the wind and tack took in main top gallant sail

Wednesday Jan. 25th

Fresh breeze from N.W. in the first part of the day we Cape off and steered N.E. and then E.N.E. but saw nothing and then steered E. in the latter part steered S.E. by E. Course and the wind become very light
