

Remarks on Board Barque C. W. Morgan

Thursday Jan. 26th

Light breeze from N.E. and pleasant the Barque steering E.S.E. all sails out in the first part of the day latter part light air and calm. Saw Grampus and plenty Birds and the crew employed in setting up midgins riggin

Lat. 39-26 Long. 15-22 E.

Friday Jan. 27th

This day commences with light breeze from W. and Barque steering E.S.E. middle part wind hauled to S.E. and became quiet thick and foggy Barque steered by the wind in the latter part became calm

Saturday Jan. 28th

First part of this begins with calm and very smooth middle and latter part fine breeze and variable the Barque steered S.E. by E. with all sails out we Bent some new sails Main stay sail and Fore top mast stay sail and rose wheel rope

Lat. 39-07 S. Long. 17-29 E.

Cape of Good Hope

Sunday Jan. 29th

Light breeze from N.E. and smooth the Barque steering S.E. by E. in first part of the day saw one vessel and saw school Black fish middle part steered S.E. the wind N.W. latter part strong breeze at 1 P.M. saw whales lower three Boats struck one took him long side at 5 P.M. raised by Mr. Lawrence first Mate

Lat. 38-41 S. Long. 19-14 E.

Monday Jan. 30th

Moderate breeze from W. the Barque laying with whale long side stopping for a better weather to cut at sun down weather more moderate

Lat. 39-06 South

Indian Ocean of New Bedford C. F. Keith Master on whaling

Thursday Jan. 31st

Strong breeze and very rugged the lying to with ~~shale~~ long side no chance to cut at 5 A.M. we hauled on but lared away the cutting stage all to pieces and we fast down in the latter part blowed heavy wind about N.W.

Lat. 39-51 South

Wednesday Feb. 1st

Strong winds from N.N.W. and squally the Barque are lying to with whale long side at 5.30 A.M. we commence to cut the weather being so bad we lost head and saw Body in the latter part we got true cutting and Cape off commence Boiling at 4 P.M. Large Ship Past us and steered S.E. at sundown wind hauled to South

Thursday Feb. 2nd

Moderate breeze from S.E. Barque heading about E. middle part rainy in the latter part the wind hauled to E. Bark head S. and S.W. got true boiling weather quiet Clear Lat. 38-56 South

Friday Feb. 3rd

Fresh breeze from E. and foggy weather in the first part of the day the Barque heading about E. and then came up S.E. in the latter part the same and weather thick but smooth saw number seven Barks

Lat. 38-51 S. Long. 24-38 E.

Saturday Feb. 4th

Light breeze from N.E. in the first part and foggy weather Barque steering S.E. by E. middle part calm we stopped down in the latter part Clear but no wind the weather very cloudy
