

Remarks on Board Barque C. W. Morgan of

Sunday Feb. 5th

This day commences with strong breeze from N.W. and squally weather the Bark steering S.E. by E. in the first of the day with fore top sail in, middle and latter wind hauled to S.W. and Blowed fresh the Barque under double Reef fore top sail and whole main top sail jib all on the Bark steered S.E.

Lat. 39-20 Long. 29-22 E.

Monday Feb. 6th

Light breeze from N.W. in the first of the day Barque steering S.E. at 5:30 A.M. raised whales lower three boats struck one and lost in the latter part fresh breeze from E.S.E. after losing whale we by the wind heading about S.E.

Lat. 39-37 S Long. 30-57 E.

Tuesday Feb. 7th

Light breeze from E.S.E. and heavy swell running to Eastward the Barque heading by the wind in the first of the day in the latter part fresh breeze from E. Barque heading about S.E.

Lat. 40-07 Long. 32-25 E.

Wednesday Feb. 8th

Strong breeze from E. to N.E. in the first of the day middle and latter part foggy Barque steered S.E. by E. at 4:30 took in light sails

Lat. 40-58 S Long. 35-09 E.

Thursday Feb. 9th

Fresh breeze from S.W. and rainy in the first part middle and latter part more moderate Bark steered S.E. and then wind hauled to S. Barque steered by the wind heading about E.S.E.

This day begins with calm and light airs in the first part of the day in the latter part light breeze from N.E. and heavy swell from W. Barque steering S.E. by S. we repaired main top sail & Mizzen top and stay sail but did not finish

Fine breeze from N.E. and smooth in the first part Bark steered S.E. by S. middle and latter part the same steered S.E. with all sails out and wind hauled to N.N.E. Lat. 43-20 S Long. 42-52 E.

Monday Feb. 13th

This day begins with light breeze from N in the first part middle and latter part foggy at 8 o'clock P.M. raised spouts but we did not find them out the Barque steered S.E. and then S.E. by E. wind S.W. at 4 P.M. took in main sail & main top gallant sail Bent mizzen top mast stay sail

Moderate breeze from S.W. and cloudy in the first part Barque steering S.E. by E. with main top gallant sail out and fly jib middle and latter part fine breeze wind hauled to W.S.W. Barque steered S.E. saw plenty feed Barks at sundown took in sail the Barque still steering Course Lat. 43-45 S Long. 47-52 E.
