Remarks on Board Barque C. W. Morgan of New Bedford C. F. Keith Master on whaling voyage

Wednesday Feb. 15th

Light breeze from S.W. and pleasant all this day the Barque steered S.E. at N. Steered S. at 4 P.M. hauled by the wind heading about S.W. wind westward saw number four Backs

Lat. 44-03 Long. 49-30 E.

Thursday Feb. 16th

Fresh breeze from N. and cloudy weather in the first part we made some sails and steered S. saw one vessel heading to eastward in the latter part strong breeze we came to by the wind heading about W.N.W. at sundown took in foresail

Friday Feb. 17th

This day begins with moderate blow from N.W. Barque heading about N.W. in the first part in the latter part thick weather at 3 P.M. commenced to rain at 4 P.M. wind hauled to W. we wore ship and head N. and N.W.

Saturday Feb. 18th

Light breeze from N.W. and pleasant in the first part of the day in the latter part the same Barque steered S.E. by S. and S.E. at sundown took in all sails and came to by the wind

Sunday Feb. 19th

This day begins with moderate breeze from N. and clear weather at 5.30 A.M. we came off and steered S. under whole main top sail at 10.30 A.M. saw the Island and run for them in latter part strong breeze wind the same from N. at Crozeatt Island 21 days from Cape of good Hope Lat. 46-12 Long. 50-30 E.

Monday Feb. 20th

Strong breeze from W. and rugged in the first part of the day Barque steering by the wind heading about N. in the latter part more moderate Barque under small sails at sundown took in fore sail we saw plenty four backs

Tuesday Feb. 21st

Strong breeze from N.W. and rugged in the first part of the day Barque heading to westward middle part more round head to N.E. under small sails in the latter part moderate at 1.30 P.M. made some sail and steered E.

Wednesday Feb. 22nd

This day commences with light breeze from N.W. and Barque steering E. with all sails out but fore top gallant sail middle in latter part fresh breeze and wind hauled little more to eastward

Lat. 43-43 S. Long. 54-02 E.

Thursday Feb. 23rd

This day begins with fine breeze from N.W. the Barque steering E. by S. with double reef fore top sail and whole main middle part strong breeze latter part the same at 10 P.M. took in main top gallant sail and speaker at 4 P.M. took in and closed reefed fore top sail at 7 P.M. took in jib and main sail the wind squally and cloudy weather

Friday Feb. 24th

Strong wind from N. and rugged the Barque steering E. by S. half S. with close reef top sails and fore sail in the first part of the day middle part moderate in the latter part squally the wind hauled to S.W. and rainy Barque steered S.E. with small sails
