the Barque steering S.E. by E. with
main top gallant sail set and reefed
fore top sail but the weather is very
cloudy

Wednesday Mar. 8th

Light breeze from W. to S.W. and cloudy
weather all this day Barque steering
S.E. by E. at sundown became calm

Lat. 40-27 S. Long. 92-54 E.

Thursday March. 9th

Light breeze from N.W. and pleasant
the Barque steering S.E. by E. in the first
part of the day but in the latter part
fresh breeze and course is the same

Lat. 40-33 S. Long. 94-59 E.

Friday March. 10th

Strong breeze from N.W. and thick weather
in the first part of the day Barque
steering S.E. by E. in the latter part wind
S.W. and still strong and rugged

Lat. 40-54 S. Long. 98-41 E.

Saturday March. 11th

Strong breeze from S.W. and very rugged
with heavy swell rolling daniel the
Barque steering S.E. by E. and then E by
S. middle and latter wind west by
and blowing heavy took in main top
gallant sail and double reefed fore
top sail got ready for bad weather

Remarks on Board Barque C. F. Keith Master in Indian

Sunday Mar. 12th

Moderate gale from S.W. and Barque running
steering S.E. in the first part of the
day at 7.30 A.M. we met with heavy fog
by the heavy sea we lost waist Boat and
most all the things in her Barque under
her whole main top sail and close reefed
fore top sail and fore sail but after
goodill work we picked up Boat all stowed
to Peaces in the latter part the same
we steered off E. by S. with lower main
top sail and weather very rugged

Monday March. 13th

Moderate breeze from S.W. in the
first part of the day Barque steering
S.E. by E. with main top gallant
out middle and latter part fresh
breeze from S.W. Barque steered S.E. by
E. Broke up the waist boat

Lat. 40-29 S. Long. 1-09-00

Tuesday March. 14th

Fresh breeze from W. in the first part of the
day middle and latter part strong breeze
and rainy weather Barque steered S.E. by E.
and then E by S. S. main top gallant sail
out we heated some water to cream for

Lat. 40-53 S. Long. 1-11-02 E.

Wednesday Mar. 15th

Strong breezes from S.W. and squally
weather in the first of the day Barque
steering E. by S. S. took in sails
to the closed reefed topsails and made
some sails again middle and latter
part the same strong breeze and ru-
gged
