Saturday April 29th
Strong breeze from W.N.W. in the first part of the day and ruggid in the latter part moderate and clear Barque under short sails

Sunday April 30th
Fresh breeze from W. in the first of the day middle and latter part moderate Barque Cruising at sundown took in all sails

Squally weather

Monday May 1st
Strong breeze from N.W. and Squally weather in the first part but in the latter part more moderate Barque Cruising at Sundown took in sails

Tuesday May 2nd
Strong breeze from W. and variable most of the day the Barque Cruising but nothing in sight this day took in sails at sundown

Wednesday May 3rd
Light breeze from W. to W.N.W. all this day Barque heading to N.N.W. in the latter part smooth and rainy but most calm wind very light

Thursday May 4th
Light breeze from S. in the first part of the day and pleasant Bark heading to westward in the latter part wind hauled to S.W. we took ship and head to S.S.E. and Sundown took in light sails

Friday May 5th
Light breeze from W. in first part in the latter part from W.N.W. and fresh

Saturday May 6th
Strong breeze from N.W. and Squally weather in the first part in the latter part more moderate Barque heading to S.S.W. under short sails at 4 P.M. wore ship and head to N.W. under closed reef top sails

Squally weather

Sunday May 7th
Light breeze from S. and wavy swell and Barque heading to Westward and then steered W.N.W. in the latter part we wore ship and steered S.N.E. at Sundown took in sails

Squally wind

Monday May 8th
Fresh breeze and pleasant in the first part of the day and smooth wind from N.W. but in the latter part the same Barque steered to eastward at 2 P.M. saw white water jampus
Lat. Long. 174-59 E.

Tuesday May 9th
Strong breeze from N.N.W. and clear weather in the first of the day Barque heading to N.E. under short sails in the latter part Squally and rainy took in fore sail at sundown wind hauled to W. Barque head N. by W.

Wednesday May 10th
Light breeze from W. and pleasant in the first of the day in the latter part calm

Thursday May 11th
This day begins with calm in the first part in the latter part light breeze from N.W. and rainy the Barque heading to the S.W. with ship out side
