Moderate breeze from W.S.W. in the first part of the day at 6:30 A.M. raised the Island and supposed to be about 25 miles off in the latter part more moderate but fine rain squalls once and while

Monday May 15th

Strong breeze from W.N.W. and ruggd the Barque heading to S.W. with main top gallant sail out in the first part but in the latter part more moderate but the weather is very cloudy took in sail at sundown

Strong breeze from W.N.W. and squally all this day and Barque heading to the South and S.E. W. by tides under short sails

Wednesday May 17th

Light breeze from S. in the first of the day middle and latter part calm

Thursday May 18thScrape
masts

This day begins with calm in the first part of the day middle and latter part light and variable wind and Barque steering about W. with main top gallant sail out we commence to scrape masts

Friday May 19th

Light breeze from S. and pleasant all this day Barque steered W. with all sails out at sundown took in sails

Lat. 31-13 S Long. 177-36 E.

Saturday May 20th

Light breeze from S. in the first part of the day middle and latter part fresh breeze from S.E. and smooth Barque steered W. with all sails but fore top gallant sail

Sunday May 21st

This day begins with light breeze from S.E. middle and latter part calm we saw two hump Dolphin bottom and Barque steered W. by S. with all sails out

Monday May 22^d

Fresh breeze from N.E. in the first part of the day Barque steering S.W. middle and latter part strong breeze and Barque steered S.W. wind S. and the weather very cloudy

Strong breeze from E.N.E. in the first part Barque steered S. by W. middle and latter moderate gale from E. at 7 P.M. we commenced to take in all sail but main lower top sail
