Remarks on Board Barge C. W. Morgan of New

Monday June 19th

Light breeze from E. in the first part of the day in the latter part cloudy and the weather looks rainy we at mangonui

Tuesday June 20th

This day begins with cloudy weather and rainy. Fresh breeze from N.W. we got off some water and we found three of the run away men the weather are not very good but we have two anchors down

Wednesday June 21st

Light breeze from E.S.E. and rainy weather all this day and we got one more boat load of wood and stowed it down and for and other run away

Thursday June 22^d

This day commences with heavy rain in the first part of the day in the latter part clear up and the steamer left for Akaroa first to Bay of Island

Friday June 23^d

Fine weather all this day we took in one boat load of wood and potatoes got everything ready for sea

Saturday June 24th

Strong breeze from E.W. all this we started to get under way but the weather being so bad we could not and on account of fould anchors but got clear ready for going the Captain and his wife came on Board all for going but did not decide and so we postponed

Sunday June 25th

Strong breeze from W. and squally in the first part of the day middle and latter part the same the weather being so unpleasant we drop second anchor part of the crew are ashore at church the Captain left ship at 5 P.M. and sundown more moderate

Monday June 26th

Strong breeze from N.W. and squally weather in the first part of the day middle and latter part moderate the Barge still lying at mangonui harbor with two anchors down waiting for wind fair Capt is ashore

Tuesday June 27th

Strong breeze from W.S.W. and squally in the first of the day middle and latter part more moderate we got two last of water off

Wednesday June 28th

Light breeze all this day we are to anchor at mangonui waiting for the wind to make a start for our cruising

Thursday June 29th

This day commences with calm and smooth weather at 7.30 A.M. we got under way and towed out got breeze at 10 A.M. and altered N.E. wind S.W. and then wind hauled to E. and S.E. and latter part fine breeze and smooth steered N.E. by N. with all sails set saw three vessels

Friday June 30th

Light breeze from E.E. and squally in the first part of the day in the latter part pleasant and smooth the wind variable the Barge steering N.E. by N. and N.E.
