Remarks on Board Barge C. W. Morgan

Saturday July 1st

Fresh breeze from N.E. and cloudy weather Barge heading about E. in the first part of the day in the latter part strong breeze and squally wind hauled to S. Barge heading E. N. E. at 4.40 P.M. took in sails and painted two boats and made South state one of our Boat-steerer and took one man from forward and made him boatsteerer

Sunday July 2^d

Sunday July 2^d day commence with gale from N. and Barge under lower main top sail we saw steamer steering to S.W. at 10 A.M. we made same sail in the latter part more moderate and wind hauled to W.S.P.W.

Monday July 3^d

Strong breeze from S.W. and rugged Barge steering N. in the first part of the day in the latter part more moderate Barge under all sails

Tuesday July 4th

Fresh breeze from W.S.P.W. and smooth in the first part of the day in the latter part light breeze and pleasant and Barge steering N. with all sails out

Wednesday July 5th

Light breeze from S.W. and pleasant all this day and Barge steering N. with all sails out but jibs

Thursday July 6th

Light breeze from S.W. in the first part of the day the Barge steering N. middle and latter part the wind from W. to W.S.P.W. and the very pleasant weather

Friday July 7th

This day commences with strong breeze and squally the Barge steering N. wind W.S.P.W. middle and latter part clear up and wind hauled to S.W. at 6 P.M. came to by the wind sails all in but lower main top sail and fore top sail

Saturday July 8th

Strong breeze from S. and squally in the first part middle and latter part the same but clear Barge lying to by the wind Lat. 25-11 Long. 178-51 W.

Sunday July 9th

Light breeze from S. and pleasant in the first part of the day in the latter part the same the Barge under all sails at sundown took in all sails Lat. 24-22 Long. 178-50 W.

Monday July 10th

This day commences with calm and cloudy weather in the first part of the day in the latter part the same this day we shrouled our dack getting ready for whaling

Tuesday July 11th

This day begins with strong breeze and squally weather in the first part of the day in latter part blowed from N.E. about weather clear the Barge steered to S.E. saw seven back and school of porpoise took in fore top sail at sun down
