Remarks on Board Barque C. W. Morgan

Sunday July 23^d

Moderate breeze from N. in the first part of the day the Barque Lying to under short sails saw large merchant Bark going by in the latter part more moderate and wind hauled to N.W.

Saw Merchant Bark

Monday July 24th

Fresh breeze from S.W. in the first of the day and cloudy weather Barque Steered S.W. in the latter part quiet moderate and smooth wind hauled to S. at Sundown took in sails

Lat. 24 = 21 S.

Tuesday July 25th

Light breeze from S. and pleasant all this day Barque Steering by the wind heading about W. to W.N.W. with all sails out at Sundown took in sails

Fine weather

Wednesday July 26th

Light breeze from S. and and Barque heading to W. all this day saw black fish lowered two boats but no chance

Thursday July 27th

This day begins with light breeze from E. and squally weather Barque Steered S. middle part we came squally and rainy in the latter part strong breeze from E.N.E. saw white water run for it but did not see them again

Friday July 28th

Strong breeze from N.E. and squally weather in the first part of the day Barque Steered off W. and haul up to W.N.W. wind still N.E. and Bark under small sail at Sundown come to heading E.S.E.

Saturday July 29th

Strong breeze from N.E. and rugged in the first part Barque Steered S. with main top gallant sail out middle part quite moderate but in the latter part squally and blowing rain I hauled to N. at 4 P.M. we took in sails at 2.30 P.M. we came to by the wind heading about E. under lower main top sail

Sunday July 30th

This day commences with strong wind and rainy in the first part of the Barque Lying to middle part calm latter part fresh breeze from N.W.

Moderate Gale from N.W.

Monday July 31st

Strong breeze from S.W. to W.S.W. the Barque Steered to South with whole main top sail and fly jib in the first part of the day in the latter part moderate saw two school of porpois

Tuesday August 1st

Fresh breeze from S. to S.E. in the first part of the Barque Steered N.E. in the latter part quiet pleasant and clear saw one vessel merchant men heading to westward

Wednesday August 2^d

Fresh breeze from S.E. in the first part of the day Barque Steered to N.E. the very clear but nothing to seen in the latter part the same

Thursday August 3^d

Strong breeze from E. in the first of the day in the latter part wind from N.E.
