Remarks on Board Barge C. W. Morgan

Tuesday Sept. 12th

Strong breeze from N.E. and rugged in the first of the day middle and latter part Gale from N. the Barge Lying to under Small sail

Wednesday Sept. 13th

This day commence with Gale from W. middle and latter part wind hauled to S.W. and still blowing Barge Lying under main lower top sail & fore stay sail

Thursday Sept. 14th

Light breeze from S.W. in the first of the day we spoke and gained Bark Adline Gibbs all day and broke up at 9 P.M. the wind about S.

Lat. 26-33 South

Friday Sept. 15th

Light breeze from S.W. to W.S.W. the Bark heading to S. Adline Gibbs in sight and we are repairing fore sail

Saturday Sept. 16th

This day begins with light from N.E. and rainy Barge steering about S. middle part quiet clear we got on mending our fore sail but in the latter part cloudy and rainy the wind hauled to E. our Barge under easy sails

Sunday Sept. 17th

Strong breeze from N.E. and rainy with squalls the Barge steered about S.E. Adline Gibbs in sight and we saw another vessel whaler but we did not speak her

Monday Sept. 18th

This day begins with Gale from E.N.E. and rainy Bark Lying to middle part wind hauled to N. and then S.W. the steered to S.E. with lower main topsail and fore top mast stay sail

Lat. 28-00 Long. 179-00 W.

Tuesday Sept. 19th

Gale of wind from W. all this day and squally Barge under easy sails lower main top sail and fore top mast stay sail. Saw one whaler we supose to be Del. Adline Gibbs

Lat. 28-03

Wednesday Sept. 20th

Strong breeze from S.W. and squally in the first part of the day in the latter part more moderate the Barge steered about S.E. under easy sail

Thursday Sept. 21st

Strong breeze from S.W. in the first of the day in the latter part moderate and the wind hauled to S.E. W. and Adline Gibbs in sight

Friday Sept. 22^d

Light breeze from N.W. and pleasant all this day the Barge steered S.E. and S.S.E. Barge Adline Gibbs in sight

Saturday Sept. 23^d

Fresh breeze from W.S.W. and clear we steered S.E. under easy sails in company with Barge Adline Gibbs in the latter part quiet strong breeze and smacky we gained the Barge and broke up at 9 P.M. and steered S.E.
