Friday Oct. 6th

This day begins with strong breeze from N.W. and ruggid we steered S.S.E. in latter part more moderate gibbs just in sight at sun down

Saturday Oct. 7th

This day begins with light breeze from N.W. and cloudy weather Barge steered to the eastward in the latter part the same at 6 P.M. wind hauled to westward Adline gibbs in sight

Sunday Oct. 8th

This day begins with rain Squall and moderate breeze from S.W. middle and latter part blowed most gale from S.W. and quiet ruggid

Monday Oct. 9th

Light breeze from W. and cloudy weather in the first of the day in the latter quiet clear gibbs in sight

Tuesday Oct. 10th

Strong westerly wind and Squally weather all this day we are under short sails all day Adline gibbs in sight

Wednesday Oct. 11th

Moderate gale from S.W. in the first of the day in the latter part more moderate the wind about the same Lat. 35-00 South

Thursday Oct. 12th

Strong breeze from S.W. in the first of the day in the latter part pleasant and clear. Saw merchantman heading to S.E. with all sails out

Moderate breeze from N.W. all this day and smoggy weather Barge heading to W.S.W. with whole main top sail jib and Spanker Saw a small white water but found to be a jumper

Saturday Oct. 14th

Strong breeze from N.W. in the first part of the day and ruggid in the latter part become Squally the Barge heading to W.S.W. Lat. 37-07 South

Sunday Oct. 15th

This day begins with calm in the first part of the day middle and latter part Squally and strong breeze from Westward we made sail but had to take them in again for the being Squally weather Lat. 37-19 Long. 170 W.

Monday Oct. 16th

Fresh breeze from S.W. in the first of the day middle and latter part quiet pleasant and clear Bark under all sails we observed my Berth day had a nice time

Tuesday Oct. 17th

This day begins with rain storm thunder & lightning middle and latter part fine weather and Pleasant the wind variable the Barge working to westward

Wednesday Oct. 18th

This day begins with light breeze from N.W. middle and latter part thick and smoggy weather Barge steered S.W. with main top gallant sail out and fly jib at sun down wind hauled to W.S.W. we took in all but lower main top sail and fore top mast stay sail.
