wind hauled to S.E. at Sundown we took
in some sail Barque heading about S.W.

Friday Nov. 3^d

Light breeze from S.E. in the first pa-
art of the day middle and latter part
light air and calm the Barque heading
about S.E. wind from N.E. and
heavy swell

Saturday Nov. 4th

Fresh breeze from N.E. in the first
part the Barque steering S.E. at noon
saw whales lower three Boats and struck
and got one look him long side and
cut him in raised by Mr. John

Sunday Nov. 5th

This day commences with moderate blow
from N. and rugged in the first part
with rain in the latter part light wind
and foggy at 3 P.M. we commence to
boile.

Monday Nov. 6th

Light breeze from W. in the first of
the day Barque heading to N. and boiling
in the latter part the same we saw
whale lower three Boats but no chance
still boiling Francis Long-170-47

Tuesday Nov. 7th

Light breeze from S.W. in the first part of the
day we got truck boiling at 11 A.M. Saw whale
raised by Mr. Lawrence we lower three boats
the small struck and got stowed but we saw
whale took him long side at 3 P.M. and
cut him in raised by Kate

Wednesday Nov. 8th

Light breeze from S.E. and quiet smooth
in the first part of the day at 8 A.M. we com-
mence boiling in the latter part the same at 10
P.M. light rain we still boiling

Thursday Nov. 9th

This day begins with light wind from S.E. and
pleasant and the wind hauled to S.W. about
the middle of the day in the latter the same at
4 P.M. raised whale one and struck got on B.B.
took him long side at 130 P.M. and stowed
down

Friday Nov. 10th

This day begins pleasant in the first part we cut
in our whale in the first of the day in the
latter part the weather very cloudy the wind from
eastward the Barque heading to South

Saturday Nov. 11th

Light breeze from S. and rain squ-
alls the Barque heading to westward
under short sail in the first part
in the latter part calm and quiet
swell from S.W.

Sunday Nov. 12th

Strong breeze from S. in the first part of
the day the Barque cruising and we are boiling
commence this morning but is little squally
and the weather cloudy
