Remarks on Board Barque C. W. Morgan

Thursday Nov. 23^d

Fresh breeze from E. in the first of the day
Barque steering to North in the latter part
wind hauled to N.E. and we are in com-
pany with ship California

Friday Nov. 24th

Fresh breeze from N. in the first part
and smooth the Barque heading to
the westward we tack ship and head
to eastward California in sight in
the latter part strong breeze from
N.E. the Barque heading to N.W. at
sundown we look in the light

Lat. 40=42 Long. 172=46 W

Saturday Nov. 25th

Strong breeze from N.N.E. in the first part
of the day and rainy weather the Barque was
heading to the N.E. but the weather being so bad
we took in some sail in the latter part more
moderate but foggy the wind hauled to N.
the Barque heading E.N.E.

Sunday Nov. 26th

Strong breeze from N.W. and thick weather
in the first part of the day the Barque
steered N.E. by N. in the latter part clear
and more moderate at 5 P.M. steered N.
by E. with main top gallant sail out

Lat. 39=35 Long. 171=35 W.

Monday Nov. 27th

Light breeze from E. in the first of
the day the Barque steered N. and
at 1 P.M. the weather very pleasant we
put up our Rope Pennant took down
our chime in the latter part the
same

Tuesday Nov. 28th

This begins with light wind and calm
and California in sight at 10 A.M.
Saw whales lower three boats and
got two whales look them long
side at night in the latter part
light breeze from S. B. B. one
S. B. one whales raised by Diago

Wednesday Nov. 29th

Strong breeze from S.E. and squally weather
we put in our whales and got three at
sundown at latter part wind hauled at
S.E. and still squally

Thursday Nov. 30th

Strong breeze from S. in the first part of
the day we commence boiling but weather
being so bad we took down and Barque
lying to with lower main topsail saw
Whright whales could not lower Boats

Friday Dec. 1st

Strong breeze from S. and rugged we are
boiling our whales in the first of the day
in the latter part the same but squally

Saturday Dec. 2^d

Strong breeze from S.E. and thick weather
in the first part of the day in the latter
part more moderate and wind the same
and are still boiling

Sunday Dec. 3^d

Light breeze from E.S.E. in the first part
of the day and quiet thick weather but
in the latter part clear and pleasant we
got true boiling our whales
