Remarks on Board Bark C. W. Morgan of New Bedford

Monday Dec. 4th

Light breeze from E. to N.E. in the first part of this day middle and latter part Calm the crew employed in stowing down all day the Barque working to the South

Tuesday Dec. 5th

Light breeze from N.E. in the first of the day Barque steering E.S.E. in the latter part fine breeze at 1 P.M. raised whales we lower four boats and weist Boul struck and lost whales raised by Cooper

Wednesday Dec. 6th

This day commences with light breeze from N. in the first of this day in the latter part Calm but the Barque steered E.S.E. in the first we scrape our Bone

Thursday Dec. 7th

Light breeze from E. and pleasant in the first of the day saw ship California and we wash our Bone in the latter part light air at 6 P.M. saw wright whale lower and L. B. struck we took in long slide at 9.30 P.M.

Friday Dec. 8th

Light breeze from E. and pleasant we cuttin our whale and California in sight in the latter part the same the hauled to South

Saturday Dec. 9th

Light breeze from S. in the first part of the day and smooth we commence Bailing the ship California in sight at 9.30 we raised wright whales but made no signal and California made signal and ship took chance we lower four boats but lost chance and we came on Board went bailing fresh breeze in the latter part

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Remarks on Board Bark C. F. Keith Master in South Pacific ocean

Sunday Dec. 10th

Strong breeze from S. in the first part and Barque under short sails bailing California in sight in the latter part more moderate the wind hauled to S.W. we got true bailing at about 8 P.M.

Monday Dec. 11th

Fresh breeze from S. in the first of this day California in sight at 9.30 A.M. we came off and run to North and we Bounded our Bone in the latter part pleasant at sun down we came to by the wind heading to westward

Tuesday Dec. 12th

Light breeze and pleasant in the first part of the day in the latter Calm all hands employed in stowing down oil and shifed some water

Wednesday Dec. 13th

Light breeze from S.W. and pleasant the Barque steering S.E. by the wind in the first part of the day in the latter part tack ship and head to westward with all sails out at sundown took in the light sails wind about the same

Lat. 38=30 South Long. 169=30W

Thursday Dec. 14th

Light breeze from S. and very fine weather in first part of this day we wash our Bone in the latter part the same wind hauled to S.E. and Barque heady about S.W. Lat. 38=09 Long. 172=03 W.

Friday Dec. 15th

Calm in the first part of the day but in middle and latter part light breeze from S. and then hauled to west the Bark turned S. by E. the weather is fine
