Thursday Jan. 18th

Strong breeze from S.W. all day and
work up to the lower boats and went
shore got Potatoes and Bullock and
6 sheep come Board about 5 P.M.

Friday Jan. 19th

Strong breeze from S.E. in the first
part of the day middle and latter part
wind hauled from S.W. and very rugged
at about 7 P.M. Sea struck the vessel
and Stove Bow Boat the Barque
Lye to look in fore top sail

Saturday Jan. 20th

Strong breeze from S.W. to S.E. the Bark
steered E. by N. under whole main top sail
in the latter part more moderate at
Sun down came to by the wind

Sunday Jan. 21st

Fresh breeze from W.S.W. in the first part
of the day the Barque heading to the S.
Spoke and gained Barque Alaska in
the latter part the wind hauled to N.W.

Monday Jan. 22^d

Strong breeze from N.W. and thick fog in
the first part of the day middle and latter
part more moderate and quiet clear the
Barque under small sails and wind
hauled to S.W.

Tuesday Jan. 23^d

Strong breeze from S.W. and rugged all
this day the Barque steered N. in the first
of the day in the latter part came to
heading to about S.E. the wind S.W.
but the weather is very rugged

we under short sails ship California in
sight we saw her lower Boats for whales
but did not get any she got boat up set

Friday Jan. 26th

Strong breeze from S. and rugged in the first
part of the day middle and latter
more moderate and quiet clear we
made little sail and steered to the
E.S.E. steering by the wind
Lat. 44-32 South

Saturday Jan. 27th

Light breeze from S. in the first part of the
day in the latter part fresh breeze and
wind hauled to westward saw two whales
California and Splendid

Sunday Jan. 28th

Fresh breeze from W.N.W. in the first part
of the day and quiet smoky middle and
latter part more clear three ships in sight
we gained Alaska

Monday Jan. 29th

Strong breeze from S.W. and rainy in the
first part of the day middle and latter
part more clear and hauled to south
two whales in sight
