Remarks on Board Bark C. W. Morgan of New

Wednesday Jan. 31st

This day begins with light breeze from S.W. and clear middle and latter part the same the weather is very pleasant the wind variable Ship California in sight

Thursday Feb. 1st

Strong breeze from N. in the first part of the day and smoky weather middle and latter part saw the islands and saw three vessels the weather more clear and the wind hauled to N.W. Ship California Alaska & Splendid all in sight

Friday Feb. 2^d

Fresh breeze from N.W. and thick weather in the first part of the day in the latter part foggy and the wind hauled to S.E. and we saw Bark Alaska and we saw two other vessels

Saturday Feb. 3^d

This day begins with calm in the first part of the day middle and latter part light breeze from N.W. and fog the rocks and the island are in sight

Sunday Feb. 4th

Light breeze from N.W. in the first part and smooth but little foggy and we are steering to N. and E.

Monday Feb. 5th

Strong breeze from N.W. in the first part of the day in the latter part blizzard gale from the same quarter the Bark Lye to with short sails

Tuesday Feb. 6th

Strong breeze from S.E.W. and very rugged in the first of this day in the latter part blizzard so we took in all sails and Lye to with lower main top sails and fore stay sail

Fine weather all day

Wednesday Feb. 7th

Fresh breeze from S.E.W. in the first part and cloudy day middle and latter quiet moderate we some sail and steered to westward by the wind and wind hauled to S.

Thursday Feb. 8th

This day commences with light breeze from S. in the first part of the day middle and latter part calm and the weather very cloudy
Lat. 42-30 South

Friday Feb. 9th

Light breeze from N.W. in the first part of the day in the latter part strong breeze and rugged gained Bark Splendid of New Zealand the Splendid this is an English Bark got sperm whale made 60 Barrels of oil and they took from him 880 Pounds of Ambergris

Saturday Feb. 10th

Strong breeze from N.W. and thick weather in the first part of the day middle and latter part rain and wind hauled from N.W. to S. and we saw a whaler running to the North

Sunday Feb. 11th

Strong breeze from S. and then S.E.W. with cloudy weather we gained two vessels Adeline Gibbs and Alaska in the latter part we saw land

Monday Feb. 12th

Strong breeze from S.E.W. and hauling to the S. all this and squally weather two vessels in sight Adeline Gibbs and Alaska in the middle part we saw the Island we repaired Mizzen top mast stay sail
