

Remarks on Board Barque C. W. Morgan of

Tuesday Feb. 13th

This day begins with calm in the first part of the day middle and latter part strong breeze from W.N.W. the Barque under small sail

Wednesday Feb. 14th

These 24 hours fresh breeze from N.W. and gloomy dark weather lets vessels in sight in the first part of the day but in the latter only one in sight the gibbs

Thursday Feb. 15th

All this day has been foggy from morning until night Barque Adeline Gibbs close by all day and calm all day

Friday Feb. 16th

Light breeze from N.W. and foggy in the first of the day in the latter part clear and become calm spoke and gained gibbs

Saturday Feb. 17th

This day commences with light variable wind and thick fog in the first part of the day in the latter part clear and pleasant Barque in sight

Sunday Feb. 18th

This day commences with strong breeze from N.W. at 6:30 A.M. commences to rain at 11:0 A.M. heavy squall and blow very fresh we took in fore top sail in the latter part become moderate and wind hauled to S.W. we head about W.

Monday Feb. 19th

Fresh breeze from N.E. and heavy drizzle from S. we steered W.N.W. in the first part in company with Adeline Gibbs in the latter part strong breeze saw the Island and two more vessels

Tuesday Feb. 20th

Strong breeze from N.E. and thick weather in the first part of the day middle and latter part clear three vessels in sight at 7 P.M. become moderate we saw Pyramid Rock

Wednesday Feb. 21st

Moderate breeze from N. and quiet thick weather all day we three vessels and gained Barque Alaska saw the Island

Thursday Feb. 22^d

Light breeze from N.W. and thick rainy weather all this day the Islands are in sight in the first part of the day and Barque Alaska in the latter part westward & by S. at 7 P.M. took in sail and rain quiet hard wind hauled to W.N.W.

Friday Feb. 23^d

Strong wind from S. and rugged in the first part of the day at 6:30 A.M. we Cape off and steered N.W. for the Island at 9 A.M. saw the Island and wind hauling to the East in the latter part moderate at 3:30 we lof from land heading to the N.E. by E.

Saturday Feb. 24th

Light breeze from E. and moderate all this day at 9 A.M. we lower two Boats and went fishing Come Board at 5 P.M. the Island are in sight

Sunday Feb. 25th

Strong breeze from N.E. and clear in the first part of this day but in the latter part cloudy weather and wind hauling to the North the Island 44 in sight Bearing about W. at 7 P.M.
