

Remarks on Board C. W. Morgan of New Bedford

Wednesday March 21st

Strong breeze from W. and very heavy swell from S. in the first part at 6 A.M. we Cape off and Steered E. the weather squally in the latter part more moderate at 130 P.M. saw one vessel at 3 P.M. saw the Island

Thursday March 22^d

Strong breeze from W. in the first part of the day and little squally in and latter part quiet smooth and moderate California in sight and the Island in sight

Friday March 23^d

Light breeze from W. N. W. in the first of the day middle part breeze from S. but in the latter part light breeze from S. W. and fine rain we saw Goat Island and Sandy Island California and gained her at Sun down became calm

Saturday March 24th

This day begins with fine breeze from W. and pleasant we Painted two over head Boats and repaired Sparker in the latter part the same two vessels in sight and the Island in sight

Sunday March 25th

This commences with calm in the first part of the day in the latter part light breeze from S. and very smooth two ships in sight and the Island

Monday March 26th

Fresh breeze from E. and then hauled to S. E. gained Sailing gills saw California took a whale mainmast fore top sail

Tuesday March 27th

This day commences with strong breeze from E. and the quiet middle part very stormy the Bark under small sail the Sailing gills in sight in the first part but in the latter so thick we could not see her and could not see land

Wednesday March 28th

The first part of this day Gale from E. with heavy rain in the latter part more moderate the wind hauled to S. N. E. the Bark under lower main top sail

Thursday March 29th

This day begins with strong breeze from N. N. E. and fair storms in the first part of the day in the latter blowed Gale of wind and we Steered off to S. W.

Friday March 30th

This day begins with squall in the first of the day middle and part became moderate and wind hauled to W. and S. W. with heavy swell from W.

Saturday March 31st

This day begins with light breeze from S. in the first part of the day middle and latter part calm we repaired Main sail

Sunday April 1st

Light breeze from S. in the first of the day middle part quiet calm at about 11 A.M. we raised School of whales we layed four Boats all struck but lost two and seven two took them long side at about 4 P.M. and let one in and we left off at 8 P.M. the wind about S. E.
