Monday April 2^d

This day Commences with light air from S.E. in the first of the day At 5.30 A.M. we commence to cut and got true at 8 A.M. at 3 P.M. commence boiling and having calm bout all day

Tuesday April 3^d

This day begins with Calm in the first of the day middle and latter part Light air from S.W. to S.E. the Bark heading to the eastward

Boiling

Wednesday April 4th

Light breeze from S.W. in the first part of the day middle and latter part wind hauled from S.W. to S.E. we got true boiling saw the Island

Goat Island in sight & cutting rock

Thursday April 5th

This day begins with light air from S.W. in the first part of the day middle and latter fresh breeze from S. Saw the Island Goat Island

Goat Island in sight

Friday April 6th

Fresh breeze from E.S.E. in the first of the day in the latter part more moderate but we had a fair squall and saw white water we run for it but did not see them again we slowed down

Slowed down to 4 knots

Saturday April 7th

This day begins with fresh breeze from N.E. in the first of the day middle part squally the Bark steered to westward in the latter part fine weather and smooth

Commence sailing

Sunday April 8th

This day begins with fresh breeze from N.E. in the first of the day at about 11 A.M. we rose whales lower all four boats and mate struck and lost the chase school until night but no more chance came on Board at dark

Saw whales raised by Mr. John

Monday April 9th

Strong breeze from N.E. and rugged all this day the Bark under short sails

Tuesday April 10th

Strong breeze from N.E. and squally all this day the Bark under closed reefed top sail we cured way fore top sail paid foot rope

Loose top sail

Wednesday April 11th

First part of this day blowed strong with heavy squall and wind N.E. but in the latter part more moderate but still raining at dark cleared up

Thursday April 12th

This day begins with rain and squally weather in the first part of the day middle part moderate at 1 P.M. saw a lone large whale we lower all four boats but no chance the whale going very quick to N.N.W. the weather cloudy the wind from N.E. in the first but in the latter part hauling to N.N.W. and we Bent new top sail fore and

Saw whale raised by Mr. John

Friday April 13th

This day light breeze from W. in the first part middle part strong breeze and heavy swell from N. in the latter pleasant and wind hauled to S.
