Thursday May 10th

Light breeze from S. in the first of the day in the latter part the same the wind hauling to S.E.

Friday May 11th

Calm all this day the all hands employed in Braking out aft hole for water and Reef

Saturday May 12th

Large ship heading S.E.

The first part of this day begins with fresh breeze from N. and Cloudy weather in the latter part Strong Breeze and Rainy we Steered S. by E. Saw a large merchant ship heading to S.E. at 5.30 P.M. we came too and took in all sails but lower main top sail

Sunday May 13th

First part of this day Commences with Blow from N.W. and heavy rain storm and hauled to W. and broke up middle and latter part more moderate we S. all day and took in fore sail at Sundown

Monday May 14th

Gale from South

This day Commence with Gale from S. and heavy rain middle and part clear but blowing the same and wind hauling to S.E. Lat. 33-12 Long. 179-35. W

Tuesday May 15th

Strong breeze from S.E. and squally weather in the first part of the day in the latter part quiet clear but the wind is strong yet and hauling to S.E.

Strong breeze from S.E. and Rugged all day with rain squall once in while the Barge under small sail

Strong breeze from S.E. in the first part of the day middle and latter part quiet moderate wind light

Saturday May 19th

Moderate breeze from S. and light squalls of rain we wore ship and head to eastward in the latter part the same

Sunday May 20th

off French Rock

Light breeze from S. all this day and pleasant the Barge Cruising off French Rock at Sundown took in sail Lat. 31-21 South

Monday May 21st

Cutter French Rock

Light breeze from S. and pleasant in the part of the day in the latter part the same but wind hauling to S.E. the Barge heading to eastward with all sails out

Fine breeze from E. in the first part of the day in the latter part wind hauled to S.E. Saw Barge Adline get and gamed French Rock in sight we got true gaming at 11 P.M. Lat. 31-12 South
