Wednesday May 23rd

Gibbs in sight
 Fresh breeze from N.E. and cloudy weather in the first part in the latter the same we steered W.N.W. in company with Gibbs

Thursday May 24th

Light breeze from N.W. in the first part of the day middle and latter part light and variable wind and the rain squalls we took in all sail Adline Gibbs in sight

Friday May 25th

Gibbs in sight
 Calm in the first part of the day middle and latter part fine breeze from S.E. and hauling to S. we lowered one boat fore a log of wood

Saturday May 26th

Gained sight
 The first part of this day begins with calm in the latter part light air from S. we gained Adline Gibbs about all day and we broke up at 9 P.M. Lat. 30-22 S.

Sunday May 27th

Saw Schooner
 Light breeze from N.E. and smooth in the first of the day middle and latter part cloudy weather and fine rain saw Schooner working to N.E. we are in company with Gibbs steered S.W. by W. all day

Monday May 28th

Wash ship
 This day begins with strong breeze from W. in the first of the day middle and latter part blowed hard and heavy squalls the Barge under small sail in company with Gibbs the crew employed in washing ship

 Strong breeze from S.W. and rugged in the first part of the day in the latter part moderate the taking whale made in top sail and fore sail jib and spanker

Wednesday May 30th

Gibbs in sight
 Fine breeze from W. and W.N.W. and pleasant all this day the Barge heading from S. to S.W. by W. with all sails out in company with Gibbs
 Lat. 31-55 Long. 174-57 E.

Thursday May 31st

Light breeze from W. all this day and Barge heading to South all day in company with Gibbs

Friday June 1st

Company with Gibbs
 The first part of this begins with light and variable wind with rain squalls in the latter part strong breeze from S.E. to S. we large merchant ship heading to E.

Saturday June 2^d

This day commence with light breeze from S.E. and squally weather in the latter part smooth and pleasant the Barge heading from S.W. to W. in company with Adline Gibbs we saw steamer heading to N.E.

Sunday June 3^d

Saw J. B.
 Variable wind and squally weather in the first part of the day in the latter part fresh breeze from N.E. and clear the Barge steered S by W. and S. saw hump back and we all so in company with Adline Gibbs
