Remarks on Board Barque C. W. Morgan of New Bedford

Sunday June 17<sup>th</sup>  
 To anchor at Mongonui this day we have very fine weather to day is Sunday

Monday June 18<sup>th</sup>  
 Fine weather all this day light breeze from S. we Braking out and setting up Shooks for water

Tuesday June 19<sup>th</sup>  
 This day we are stowing water and braking out getting ready for taking Provision with all we have very fine weather

Wednesday June 20<sup>th</sup>  
 This day begins with fine weather in the first part of this day in the latter part began to rain we took in some Provision from Steamer and stowed some water in the half whole 3 Men run away

Thursday June 21<sup>st</sup>  
 This day begins with breeze and smooth in the first part of this day we Broke out some oil and the Steamer came long side and took the oil for Bay of Island lot the runaway

Friday June 22<sup>nd</sup>  
 Fresh breeze from E. to N.E. we are still braking out in the latter part rainy and this day our Presons came on board and at 5 P.M. we let go second anchor at 8 P.M. blowed quiet strong

Saturday June 23<sup>rd</sup>  
 Fresh breeze from E. and rainy some part of the day and are still getting water and Braking out the weather are not very good about this time

Monday June 25<sup>th</sup>  
 Strong breeze from N. to S.W. we are still at work have up our anchor and let it go again in the latter part more moderate took in some water

Tuesday June 26<sup>th</sup>  
 Light breeze from S. in the first part of the day in the latter part smooth and we are still getting water and stowing whole

Wednesday June 27<sup>th</sup>  
 To anchor at Mongonui this day we have good weather but little rain once in while we took in Provision fore mother years cruise the Steamer came long side about 230pm

Thursday June 28<sup>th</sup>  
 Fine weather and light breeze all this day we are still Braking out and stowing Provision Lying at Mongonui

Friday June 29<sup>th</sup>  
 Fine and pleasant all this day we have up and clear the anchor and stowed after whole with Provision

Saturday June 30<sup>th</sup>  
 To anchor at Mongonui this day we had liberty one watch onshore the weather very fine we still at work

Sunday July 1<sup>st</sup>  
 Fine weather and pleasant all this day light breeze from S.W. all well
