

Remarks on Board Barque C. W. Morgan of New

Monday July 2^d

Fine weather all this day we are still at work getting water and crew on the Liberty to anchor at Mongonui

Tuesday July 3^d

To anchor at Mongonui still at work and now we are giving liberty

Wednesday July 4th

Fine weather all this day our work is about done but still we broke out some oil about 3.17 gallons of whale oil

Thursday July 5th

Smooth in the first of this day we land some shoes and lasts ready made and Adeline Gibbs sailed

Friday July 6th

This day commence with heavy rain from E. in the latter part the wind hauled from N.E. at sun down the weather be come better

Saturday July 7th

This day begins with fine weather & smooth we got off all the water and wood and got ready for sea at sun down commence to rain

Sunday July 8th

To anchor at Mongonui this day we have very fine weather and smooth we now about ready to sea

Monday July 9th

Fine weather all this day at 10 A.M. we got under way and towed out with 2 boats finally we drop again for the wind be come a head

Sold 317 gall. of whale oil 10 lbs. Gibbs sailed

Tuesday July 10th

This day we had blown from N.W. and heavy rain storm in the first part of the day but in the latter part quiet pleasant and clear we lay with two anchors down

Wednesday July 11th

Strong breeze from N.W. in the first part of the day in the latter part moderate & wind hauled to W.S.W. and we had one man taken out of the ship for giving Tobacco to one of the shore men one that left our ship year before the men from ship paid 2000 dollars all so one from shore

Thursday July 12th

This day commence with strong squalls from W. at 4.15 A.M. we let go second anchor at 8 A.M. the mate went on shore he has been shore fore every day the Captain is still on shore sick and we are wind Bound the mate can not sleep on the ship Board one menut i think if he be on going shore it will be a bad work here by an by he couse we all like to go a shore the steamer came in this morning at 1 A.M. the weather being rainy

Friday July 13th

Fresh breeze from W.S.W. all this day & Barque lying to an anchor at Mongonui with David Bound but we are ready for sea

Saturday July 14th

This begins with fine breeze from E. we got under way from inner harbor and come to in out harbor and betom Calm in the latter part breeze from W. we got under way and sailed on steered N.E. with fine breeze
