Sunday July 15th

This begins with fine breeze from N. and pleasant we steered E. and S.E. by E. in the latter part wind hauled to S. Saw one Brig heading to W.

Monday July 16th

Light breeze from S. in the first part of the day in the latter part rain and wind hauled to E. and E.N.E. the Barge steering by the wind we took down Spar to make yard

Tuesday July 17th

Light breeze from E. and pleasant in the first of the day in the latter part the same at 2 P.M. we rose whales lowered four boats struck 2 whales and lost one whales raised by cleo go

Wednesday July 18th

Strong breeze from N. in the first part of the day and thick rainy weather all through we cut in whale in the latter part quiet storm heavy rain

Thursday July 19th

Strong breeze from W. and squally all day we started boiling

Friday July 20th

Strong breeze from W. and raged all this day and rainy for time in the latter part we hauled to S.W. and we are still boiling and we took down at 4 P.M. the Boats all boiled out

This begins with light breeze from S.W. and pleasant we boiled the head and made some sail heading about N.W.

Sunday July 22^d

Moderate breeze from S.E. and rainy in the first part of the day in the latter part clear and pleasant we steered W. in the first of the day in the latter part saw vessel heading to eastward

Monday July 23^d

This day begins with in the first part of the day in the latter part breeze from N.E. and the Barge under small sail blowing down saw vessel we spoke to be a merchant men

Tuesday July 24th

This begins with strong breeze from N.E. and cloudy weather middle and latter part blizzard gale and rain the Barge lying to under lower main top sail

Wednesday July 25th

Moderate gale from N. and rainy with thunder and lightning in the latter part the wind hauled to N.W. and raged we wore ship and head to S.W.

Thursday July 26th

Strong winds from N. and squally in the first part of the day in the latter part the same and wind hauled from N. to W. and S. and still squally and raged

Friday July 27th

Moderate gale from S.W. all day Barge lying to with lower main top sail set by at sundown the weather became clear
