Saturday July 28th

This day begins with heavy Squall from west with thunder and lightning rain and all so Blowed quiet gale and the part moderate but in the latter part Strong breeze from W.

Heavy weather

Sunday July 29th

This day begins with heavy tempest and blowing very strong from W. the Bark lying to under lower main top sail

Monday July 30th

Strong breeze and Squally all this day the lying under lower main top sail Calm quiet often and the weather very cold

Gales of wind

Tuesday July 31st

Strong breeze from S.W. and Squally in the first part of the day but in the latter part more moderate we made little sail and head to S.E.

Lat. 34-18 South

Wednesday August 1st

This day begins with Calm in the first part of the day in the latter part light breeze from S.E. the Bark heading to Westward we work on the yard and commence to paint ship

Thursday August 2^d

Fresh breeze from S. and smooth in the first of the day in the latter part strong breeze and rugged the Barge under small sail we working on the yard got tree and painted it

Light breeze from S. and pleasant all this day we put up lower fore top sail yard and Bent new top sail and rove new main top sail Braces and fore top sail Braces

Saturday August 4th

Light breeze from S.W. and rainy in the first part of the day in the latter part quiet clear and hauled to South we Bent New Fore sail

Sunday August 5th

Strong breeze from S.E. and heavy Squall in the first of the day middle and latter part more moderate and wind hauling to S.E. the ship heading about S.

Monday August 6th

Light breeze from S.E. and pleasant all this day we cut fore top sail and double top sail and Bent the lower one

Tuesday August 7th

Light breeze and pleasant all this day but we had a little rain some part of the day the wind has been variable in the latter part of the day

Wednesday August 8th

Fine breeze from S.W. all this day and pleasant we finish our topsail and Bent in the Barge under main top sail jib and Spanker Third Mate Sick off duty

Thursday August 9th

Strong breeze from W. and Squally weather in the first part of the day in the latter part more moderate but fresh breeze and wind hauled to South the Barge head to eastward
