Calm all this day untill 5 P.M. we came light breeze from S.E. and very smooth and we are painting ship

Saturday August 11th

This day commence with calm in the first part of the day in the latter part light breeze from S. we are painting ship

All this day we have calm and very smooth weather is very pleasant saw grampus & some small fish and old log

Monday August 13th

Light breeze from N.E. and pleasant in the first part of the day we steered E.S.E. saw a schooner and steered for her and lower Boat and put letters Board in the latter part the wind hauled to N.

Tuesday August 14th

Strong breeze from N. in the first of the day the Barque steering E.S.E. in the latter part we came squally took in some sail and steered S. by E. at Sundown took all but lower main top sail and came to by the wind Lat. 37-16 South

Wednesday August 15th

First part of this begins with strong breeze from N.W. in the latter part gale from the same quarter and little squally

Moderate gale from W. in the first part of the day in the latter part gale from S.W. at 4 30 P.M. took in all sails

Saturday August 18th

This day begins with strong breeze from W.N.W. and rugged but we made some sail and heading S.W. by S. at M. we took in sail and wore ship head to N. in the latter part blowed gale the Bark lying to with lower main top sail only four men sick off duty Lat. 38-12 South

Sunday August 19th

Strong breeze from W.N.W. in the first part of the day in the latter part blowed gale from W. the Barque lying to heading about N. and N.N.W.

Monday August 20th

This day begins with gale from W.N.W. and very rugged in the latter part the wind hauled to W.S.W. weather became moderate and clear

Tuesday August 21st

This day begins with light breeze from W. hailing to N.W. we made little sail and steered S. in the latter part strong breeze from W. took in fore sail and fore top sail

Wednesday August 22^d

Strong breeze from W. in the first part of the day in the latter part blowing and squally wind hailing to S.W. the weather is very disagreeable and damp the Bark lying to with lower main top sail
