Remarks on Board Barque C. W. Morgan of

Thursday August 23^d

Strong breeze from S. in the first part of the day and heavy swell middle and latter part light breeze the wind hauling to S.E. the weather quiet rainy today we had whole main top sail jib and spanker at sundown took them in

Friday August 24th

Strong gale from E. to E.S.E. we took in all sails and lay to the wind backing to S.

Saturday August 25th

Moderate gale from S. to S.W. the Barque lying to with sails all in saw many birds flying about this day

Sunday August 26th

This day begins with moderate gale from S.E.W. middle and latter part heavy gale from W. we lay to under Bare Poole we have been so for three days

Monday August 27th

Light breeze from S.W. in the first part of the day we made all sails and head to S.E. in the latter part the wind hauled to W. with heavy swell saw number seen backs

Tuesday August 28th

This day begins with fresh breeze from W.N.W. we made little sail and steered S. in the latter part quiet moderate and wind became light at sundown took in fore sail

Wednesday August 29th

Fresh breeze from W. in the first part in the latter part moderate but smoky we steered S.E. under small sails

Light breeze from E.S.E. and clear weather in the first part of the day in the latter part wind hauled to N.E. and N.N.E. the Barque heading about E. at sundown

Lat. 38-00 South

Friday August 31st

Strong breeze from N. and smoky weather in the first of the day in the latter part very strong and rugged the Barque under two lower topsails and fore sail

Saturday September 1st

This day commences with gale from S. and rainy in the first part of the day middle and latter part moderate and foggy at sundown commence to rain again

Sunday September 2^d

Strong breeze from W. and smoky weather in the first part of the day in the latter part more moderate and clear we are under two lower top sails and fore sail

Lat. 39-00 Long. 172-00 W.

Monday Sept. 3^d

Fresh breeze from N.W. to W.N.W. all this day the Barque under two top sails jib and fore sail in the latter part the wind quiet light but heavy swell from S.W.

Lat. 38-50 Long. 172-09 W.

Tuesday Sept. 4th

Light breeze from N. to N.E. all this day the Barque under two top sails and fore sail
