

Remarks on Board Barque C. W. Morgan of New Bedford C. F. Keith Master on whaling voyage

Wednesday Sept. 5th

Light breeze from W. in the first part of the day in the latter part fresh breeze from and little rain squall wind hauled to N.W. the Barque has been under 2 top sails all day

Thursday Sept. 6th

This day begins with strong squalls from N.W. middle and latter part moderate breeze but foggy the Barque under easy sails

Friday Sept. 7th

This day commences with heavy squalls from N.W. middle part moderate in the latter part strong breeze and swell running the Barque under lower main in top sail Lat. 39-00 South 171-00

Saturday Sept. 8th

Moderate gale from W.S.W. with rain squalls in the first part of the day in the latter part the same but the wind hauled to S.S.W. still squally

Sunday Sept. 9th

Strong breeze from W.S.W. and squally all this day and Barque under easy sails

Monday Sept. 10th

Strong breeze from S.W. and squally in first part of the day in the latter part moderate and quiet pleasant the Barque under main top sail and main sail easy sails

Tuesday Sept. 11th

Calm in the first part of the day middle part light breeze from S. in the latter part rainy and squally strong wind from S. Barque heading S. with lower main top sail

Wednesday Sept. 12th

Heavy gale from S.E. and rainy all this day the Barque lying to under here Poole

Thursday Sept. 13th

Gale from S.E. in the first of the day in the latter part wind hauled to S.S.E. and still rainy and blowing

Friday Sept. 14th

Moderate gale from S.S.E. all this day the Barque lying to with out sails but the weather has been clear all day Lat. 37-13 Long. 171-53 W.

Saturday Sept. 15th

Gale from S.S.E. and heavy squalls from S. and wind hauling to S.S.W. at about 4 P.M. moderate some but heavy sea running we set main top sail and took it in again

Sunday Sept. 16th

Moderate breeze from S. in the first part of the day middle and latter part wind hauled to S.E. and light rain squalls about all day and we are under easy sails and saw one vessel

Monday Sept. 17th

Light breeze from S.E. to S.S.E. all this day and fine rain squalls most of the times the Barque under whole top sails and main top gall sail

Tuesday Sept. 18th

Strong breeze from S.E. all day Barque under easy sails heading to South and west we saw number of Backs
