

Remarks on Board Barge C. W. Morgan

Wednesday Sept. 19th

Light breeze from S.S.E. and squally all this day the Barge under easy sails heading to S.W. at 6 P.M. wind hauled to S.S.E. and wind still light

Thursday Sept. 20th

This commences with light airs and calm middle and latter part light breeze from S. to E. the Barge heading to Westward with main top gall and sail and repaired lower main top sail

Friday Sept. 21st

Light breeze from S. all day and pleasant the Barge heading to the eastward under easy sails

Saturday Sept. 22^d

Light breeze from W. and pleasant all this day the Barge under top sail steered S. and S.E. at sundown quiet swell from S.E. and became cloudy

Sunday Sept. 23^d

Fresh breeze from W. in the first of the day we steered S.E. under easy sails in the latter part moderate and wind hauled W.S.W.

Monday Sept. 24th

Light breeze from W. in the first of the day the Barge steered S.E. under main top sail and fore sail in the latter part the wind hauled to W.N.W. and became cloudy

Fresh breeze from N.W. and quiet brisk in the first part of the day in the latter part wind hauled to N. and still thick the Barge under easy sail

Wednesday Sept. 26th

Light breeze from W. and Rainy in the first part of the day middle and latter part variable and still rainy but be calm

Thursday Sept. 27th

This day begins with fresh breeze from S.S.W. with cloudy weather in the latter part moderate the wind hauled to S.W. the Barge under easy sails

Friday Sept. 28th

This day begins with fresh breeze from N.W. and quiet smoky we started at 11:45 a.m. raised eight whales lower three boats and dardied but did fasten came on Board at 4 P.M. lower again dardied but did not fasten and came on Board at Sundown raised by Mr. King

Saturday Sept. 29th

Strong breeze from N.W. and Rainy in the first part of the day middle and latter part quiet foggy and wind moderate the barge under easy sail

Sunday Sept. 30th

Moderate gale from N.W. all this day and Rainy the sea very rugged we saw Black Skin and porpoises
