

Remarks on Board Barge C. W. Morgan of

Saturday Oct. 13th

Moderate Gale from W.
This day begins with moderate gale from W. in the first part of the day middle and latter part wind from S.W. and then from W. again the Barge Lying to under lower main top sail and fore top mast stay sail

Sunday Oct. 14th

Heavy Gale
Heavy gale from W. to W.S.W. all this day we carried away lower main top sail Ratted foot rope and split sail the whole length

Monday Oct. 15th

Heavy Rain
Strong breeze and squally in the first part of the day the wind hauling from W.N.W. to S.W. and S. at last in the latter part more moderate we scrub ship and broke out water

Tuesday Oct. 16th

Repaired lower top sail
Strong breeze from S.W. and rugged in the first part in the latter quiet moderate we repaired lower main top sail and got it all ready to bent

Wednesday Oct. 17th

Light breeze from S.W. and pleasant in the first part of the day in the latter part the same very clear and wind hauled W. and very light

Thursday Oct. 18th

Saw Wright whale
Strong breeze from N.N.W. in the first part the Barge steering W.S.W. at 6 A.M. raised Wright whale we lower four Boats and chase but no chance came aboard at 11:30 and wind hauling from N.N.W. to W.S.W. in the latter part more moderate but whale going quiet fast Lat. 36-00 Long. 170-35

Friday Oct. 19th

Fresh breeze from W.N.W. and thick weather in the first part of the day in the latter part quiet clear and wind from W. hauling to the South

Saturday Oct. 20th

raised Wright whales got one
Light breeze from W. and smooth in the first part we steered S. and S.E. middle part foggy but in the latter part clear at 6 P.M. raised Wright whales we lower four boats got one raised by M.B. W.B.

Sunday Oct. 21st

Breeze from N. in the first of the day and cloudy weather we cut in whale in the latter part quiet moderate and smooth we commence bailing

Monday Oct. 22^d

Saw Whales
Light breeze from N.W. in the first part of the day we are bailing at 9:30 A.M. raised Wright in the latter part fresh breeze we lower four Boats but no chance saw number whales raised by Mr Lawrence

Tuesday Oct. 23^d

Saw Wright whale got one
Fresh breeze from N.N.W. and cloudy weather we are still bailing at 6 A.M. saw Wright whales lower and one took him long side and cut him in rain storm got true at 7 P.M. raised by Mr. King Lat. 36-40 Long. 171-40

Wednesday Oct. 24th

Fresh breeze from S.W. and Pleasant in the latter part wind from W.S.W. and we are bailing we started this morning
