

Remarks on Board Barque C. W. Morgan

Tuesday Nov. 6th

St. W. Gale
Gale of wind from S.W. and heavy sea running and Barque lying to under Bare pole with about 70 Barrels of oil on the deck

Wednesday Nov. 7th

Moderate gale from S.W. in the first of the day middle and latter part quiet clear and still rugged the Bark and two lower top sails and fore stay sail

Thursday Nov. 8th

Stowed 73 bls
Strong breeze from S.W. in the first of the day middle and latter part more moderate and clear All hands employed in stowing down oil

Friday Nov. 9th

Saw whale weight 20?
This day begins with light breeze from S. and hauling to Westward middle and latter part calm raised whale at 6.30 A.M. lowered four Boats but no chance raised by Mate

Saturday Nov. 10th

This day begins with calm middle and latter part fresh breeze and variable and became cloudy and rainy at Sund own wind from S.E.

Sunday Nov. 11th

This day begins with fresh breeze from S. and squally in the first part of the day middle and latter part pleasant and clear the Bark under all sails cruising

Monday Nov. 12th

Light breeze from S.W. and light rain squalls in the first part in the latter part calm but heavy swell from S.

Tuesday Nov. 13th

Saw vessel
Light breeze from N.E. and pleasant in the first part of this day but in the latter fresh breeze and still smooth saw a vessel heading to Eastward Fourth Mate Sick off duty

Wednesday Nov. 14th

Strong breeze from N.E. and rainy in the first part of the day in the latter more moderate and still raining we steered S. at 4 P.M. came to and took in fore sail

Thursday Nov. 15th

Saw Black fish 3
Fresh breeze from N.E. and rainy in the first of the day middle part quiet clear saw Black fish in the latter part lower one Boat and the Boat tipped over long side but no one lost we lowered another Boat to save them at 4 P.M. saw Black fish again we lowered four Boats and got three Black fish

Friday Nov. 16th

Strong breeze from N.E. and rugged all this day and Barque under lower top sails and fore sail heading to S.E. at 6.30 P.M. wore ship and head to N.N.W.

Saturday Nov. 17th

one man Sick
Strong breeze from N.E. and rainy the Barque under easy sails two lower topsails and fore top mas stay sail

Sunday Nov. 18th

North Easter
Strong breeze from N.E. and heavy rain in the first part of the day in the latter part moderate and wind hauled N.N.W. and light rain
