Fresh breeze from N. in the first part of the day in the latter part quiet moderate we got true Boiling and stow down some oil Saw Hamp Back the Island in sight

Dec. Saturday 1st

Strong breeze from N. all rugged all day and heading to eastward at 7:30 P.M. we wore ship and head up the Barque under easy sail

Sunday Dec. 2^d

Strong breeze from N.W. all this day and rugged the Barque under close reefed lower top sails at 7 P.M. took in fore top sail and gyto the wind en crissing

Monday Dec. 3^d

Moderate gale from N. and rainy in the first part of the day middle part the wind hauled to W. and clear up in the latter part quiet pleasant and with light breeze the Barque under easy sails

Tuesday Dec. 4th

This day begins with heavy squalls and blowing from N. and then wind hauled to W.S.W. and become moderate so we stow down in the latter part quiet pleasant

Wednesday Dec. 5th

This begins with strong breeze from N.W. and rainy the Barque under small sails middle part Blowed hard from the same quarter but in the latter part wind hauled W.S.W. and moderate some still light rain

Strong breeze from N.W. and squally in the first part of the day in the latter part quiet moderate the under two lower top sails at 7:30 become squally we took in fore top sail repaired fore Cocks
Lat. 45-28 Long. 174-40 W.

Friday Dec. 7th

Gale from N.W.

Moderate gale from N.W. to W. and heavy squalls all this day the Barque under lower top sail at 6 P.M. took in main top sail

Saturday Dec. 8th

Gale from W.S.W.

Moderate gale from W.S.W. in the first part of the day in the latter part wind hauled to N.W. and Blowed the same the Barque under lower main top sail and fore stay sail

Sunday Dec. 9th

Gale from W.S.W.

Moderate gale from W.S.W. in the first of the day and squally in the latter part more moderate and wind hauled to S.W. the Barque lying to under Bare pole

Monday Dec. 10th

Strong breeze from S.W. and squally in the first part in the latter part more moderate the wind hauled to S. we made some sail altering by the wind heading W. and W.S.W.
Lat. 44-06 Long. 171-44 W.

Tuesday Dec. 11th

Light breeze from W.S.W. and dark and gloomy weather in the first of the day in the latter part the wind hauled to N.W. the Barque heading W.S.W. with all sails but main top gallant sail Lat. 44-00 South
