

Remarks on Board Barque C. W. Morgan

Wednesday Dec. 12th

This day begins with strong breeze from N. and rainy weather the Barque steering W. by S. and W. S. W. by times in the latter part cleared up and wind hauled to N.W. the Barque head off to S.W. the Barque under whole main top sail and lower fore top sail Lat. 44-24. Long. 175-06 W.

Thursday Dec. 13th

Strong breeze from W. S. W. and fog squalls in the first part of the day at 10:30 A.M. we saw the Island in the latter part the same but wind hauled to S.W. and moderate at sundown took in sail

Friday Dec. 14th

Light breeze and variable in the first part of the day in the latter part fresh breeze from N. and rainy the Barque steered for the Island got quiet handy and took in sails and head to eastward Reef about 2 miles Bearing N.

Saturday Dec. 15th

Strong breeze from W. and foggy weather in the first part of the day middle and latter part quiet Clear we saw the Island the Barque under whole top sails

Sunday Dec. 16th

Strong breeze from S. W. and rugged eye saw Black fish and we gained back Alaska saw the Island the Island in sight

of New Bedford C. F. Keith Master on whaling

Monday Dec. 17th

Light breeze from S. in the first of the day in the latter part fresh breeze and stormy at 5 P.M. commence to rain at 6 P.M. we took in sail and wind hauled to eastward the Barque heading to N.

Tuesday Dec. 18th

Moderate Gale from E. S. E. to S. E. E. and quiet Tugged the Barque Lye to under lower main top sail and fore top mast stay sail

Wednesday Dec. 19th

Fresh breeze from S. in the first part of the day Alaska in sight middle and latter part light wind and variable the Barque under topsails

Thursday Dec. 20th

Fresh breeze from N. N. E. to N. E. all this day we steered from S. W. to S. with all sails out Alaska in sight

Friday Dec. 21st

Strong breeze from E. N. E. and rainy in the first part in the latter part clear and wind hauled to E. S. E.

Saturday Dec. 22^d

Strong breeze from E. S. E. and foggy in the first part of the day we steered off W. at 30 A.M. saw the Island but the being thick we hauled on the wind heading to S. the weather still foggy

Sunday Dec. 23rd

Strong breeze from S. and squally all this day the Island in sight the Barque under easy sails
