Light breeze from N. in the first part of the day middle part thick fog and rainy but we saw the Island by time in the latter part clear up and the wind hauled to S.W.

Wednesday Dec. 26th

Strong breeze from S.W. in the first of the in the latter part moderate and clear Island in sight we gained Alaska

Thursday Dec. 27th

Light breeze from W. hauling to N.W. and N. the Island close by we lower two boats & went fishing in latter part strong breeze

Friday Dec. 28th

Strong breeze from N.W. and thick in the first part in the latter part blow from S. the Barque under short sails

Saturday Dec. 29th

Heavy gale from N.W. and rainy in the first of the day in the latter moderate

Sunday Dec. 30th

Heavy gale from S.W. all this day and squally weather the Barque under Bare pole been so for three days

Monday Dec. 31st

Gale of wind S.W. in the first part of the day in the latter part wind hauled to S. the weather is little better but heavy sea on running to N. the wind has been blowing since Friday the Barque under bare pole Lat. 44-20 Long. 174-54 W.

Heavy gale from S.W. to W.S.W. all this day and squally the Barque under bare pole the Captain still sick

Wednesday Jan. 2^d

Gale from S.W. and heavy squalls of rain all this day the Barque under Bare Pole and Captain still sick

Thursday Jan. 3^d

This day begins with tempest wind from N.W. hauling to N with heavy squalls middle and latter part the wind hauled to N.W. and W.S.W. blowing gale in the morning we made little sails and took them in again at 3 P.M. Captain still sick Lat. 44-01

Friday Jan. 4th

This day commences with strong breeze from W. and heavy swell middle part moderate but in the latter part become fine weather and smooth wind hauled to S.W.

Lat. 43-55 South

Saturday Jan. 5th

Light breeze from S. and wind hauling to S.E. we steered W. and W.S.W. with all sails out at sun down took in sails

Saturday Jan. 6th

Light breeze and variable all day and calm by times but the wind being so light we could not make much head way at sun down took in sails and Captain still sick and is son out Lat. 43-50 South
