Monday Jan. 28th

Light breeze from N. and pleasant in the first of the day the Barge steering S.E. middle part Steered S. in the latter part fresh breeze and quiet thick saw merchant man heaving to S.E. and are signalled at Sun down we came to by the wing head ding W. under two lower top sails
Lat. 43-37 Long. 174-56 W.

Tuesday Jan. 29th

Strong breeze from N.W. and rainy in the first part of the day the Bark Steered S. by W. middle part moderate but in the latter part thick weather and blowing the wind hauling to W. at 7 P.M. the Barge heading about S.S.W. under two lower top sails saw Alaska Lat. 44-30 South

Wednesday Jan. 30th

Strong breeze from S.S.W. and rainy Alaska in sight at 6 A.M. we came off in company with Alaska steering to us toward at 9 A.M. saw Chatham Island and we came to Pito Island and Capt. with Boats crew went on shore mate and I took Barge in to Chatham Harbor to anchor in 17 Fathom water

Thursday Jan. 31st

To anchor at Chatham Island for water in the first of the day the wind being S.W. in the latter part got under way and sailed over to Pito Island got potatoes and some sheep the Captain stop on shore and the mate took the ship on a cruise

Light breeze from N. in the first part of the day middle part the same but in the latter part strong breeze and rainy wind hauled to W. and then S. the Island in sight and saw the Alaska came out

Saturday Feb. 2^d

Strong breeze from S.S.W. and rugged in the first part of the day at 6 A.M. raised one lone whale we lower three boats but no chance lost the run of the whale east reef about 15 miles off bearing N.E. we the ship California in the latter part quite moderate and pleasant the raised by Cooper

Sunday Feb. 3^d

Light breeze from S.S.W. in the first of the day and smooth middle and latter part variable wind and vary light the Island in and saw the vessels California & Alaska

Monday Feb. 4th

Fresh breeze from N.W. in the first of the day and smooth Alaska in sight mate lower Boat and went on Board of her for few minutes he brought on 22 sheep and 16. Bore in the latter part the same at 7 15 P.M. saw whales but was too late we did not lower Alaska in sight the whales raised by Francisco Alves

Tuesday Feb. 5th

Strong breeze from N.W. and rugged all day two vessels in sight the Alaska and California Capt. Fisher came on Board from Alaska to our ship for few minutes saw Black fish stand watch
