Wednesday Feb. 6th

Strong breeze from N.W. and rainy in the first part of the day at 10 A.M. wind hauled to E. and wind blown two vessels in sight Alaska California in the latter part pleasant we steered W.N.W. at 5:30 P.M. Saw the Island the two vessels still in sight

Thursday Feb. 7th

Fresh breeze from S.E.W. in the first part of the day the Island closed by in the morning at 7 A.M. we sent Boat shore Capt. Come off brought off some sheep and potatoes and bits at 2 P.M. Saw two ship cutting at 7 P.M. Capt. sent boat on Board of the Alaska

Friday Feb. 8th

Fresh breeze from S. and S.E.W. to S.E. hauled all day the two ships in sight hailing and the Island in sight all so at sundown between east & Ref 8.44

Saturday Feb. 9th

Strong breeze from S.E. and squally in the first of the day but in the latter part more moderate two vessels in sight

Sunday Feb. 10th

Light breeze from S.E. and light rain squalls at 10 A.M. the wind hauled to E. but in the latter part became pleasant and quiet clear the Barque under all sails two vessels in sight and the Island all so

Thursday Feb. 14th

Strong breeze from S.W. and rugged in in the first of the day we made same sail and steered for the Island in the latter part more moderate at 1 P.M. Saw the Island and saw three vessels

Friday Feb. 15th

Strong breeze from N.W. in the first part in the latter part moderate and cloudy the weather quiet thick but the Island in sight and three vessels in sight

Saturday Feb. 16th

This day begins with light breeze E. and quiet foggy middle part the same but in the latter fresh breeze from N. two vessels in sight and we gained Alaska saw the Island

Sunday Feb. 17th

Strong breeze from W.N.W. and foggy all day but saw two ships and the Island at sundown wind S.W.
