Friday March 14th

Light breeze from S.W. and foggy in the first part of the day middle part breeze from S.E. and still foggy in the latter part. Pleasant the Barque steering W. and W. by S.

Saturday March 15th

Strong breeze from E. and rain the Barque steering W. by S. we all sails out in the first part of the day in the latter part heavy storm with variable wind and heavy rain.

Sunday March 16th

This day begins with calm and rain middle part fresh breeze from S.W. hauling to W. in the latter part pleasant at 2 P.M. saw the land and the weather become quiet thick at 6 15 P.M. saw whales but being late we did not lower.

Lat. 33-42 Long. 172-03 E.

Monday March 17th

Light breeze and variable with drizzling rain and fog most of the day at 5-30 P.M. light up we saw land bearing S.E. 15 miles we bent two new sails main gallant sail and mizzen top stay sail.

Tuesday March 18th

Light breeze from E. and pleasant in the first of the day Barque steering S.W. by W. in the latter part wind hauled to N.E. we steered W. by S.

Wednesday March 19th

Fresh breeze from N. and rainy in the first part of the day middle part calm and pleasant at 5-30 P.M. got breeze from S.W.

Thursday March 20th

Strong breeze from S.W. and rugged the Barque steering by the wind heaving a boat W.N.W. under short sails in the first part but in the latter part more moderate at sun down became calm.

Friday March 21st

This begins with squalls thunder and lightning with variable wind the Barque working to westward and easy sails.

Saturday March 22^d

Strong breeze from S.W. and squally all day in the latter part the wind hauled to S.E. the Barque under easy sails.

Lat. 32-26 Long. 164-17 E.

Sunday March 23^d

The first part of this day strong breeze from S. middle and latter part moderate and quiet pleasant the Barque under whole top sails.

Lat. 33-28 Long. 163-21 E.

Monday March 24th

Light breeze from S.E. and pleasant in the first part of the day in the latter part the same the Barque working to S.W.

Tuesday March 25th

Moderate breeze from S.E. to S. all this day the Barque under whole top sails and courses.

Wednesday March 26th

Light breeze from S.W. in the first of the day in the latter part the wind hauled to S.E. and the weather still pleasant Lat. 32-10 Long. 163-23
