

Remarks on Board Barque C. W. Morgan of

Thursday March 27th
Light breeze from E.S.E. and pleasant in the first part of the day in the latter part quiet fresh breeze and hauling to E and E.N.E. at Sundown took in Sails

Friday March 28th
Light breeze from E. and Pleasant in the first part of the day in the latter fresh breeze but quiet smooth saw jumps

Saturday March 29th
These 24 hours fresh breeze from E.N.E. to N.E. and pleasant the Barque under all sails we saw Steamer

Sunday March 30th
These 24 hours begins with fine weather and pleasant at 6 A.M. Saw whales lower four boats but on account of a bad merriment we lost chance the wind E.N.E. and clear the boats came on board about 130 P.M. whales still in sight

Monday March 31st
The first part these 24 hours light breeze from E. and pleasant middle and latter part strong breeze and rugged took in all sails but two latter top sail.

Tuesday April 1st
Strong breeze from E. and very rugged all this day the Barque under easy sails working to eastward

Wednesday April 2nd
Moderate gale from E. all day Bark under two lower top sail

Thursday April 3rd
Strong breeze and rainy all this day in the first part wind from E. in the middle part wind from N.E. in the latter part wind hauled to N.N.E. and rain hard we wore ship and head E. by S. took in fore top sail

Friday April 4th
These 24 hours begins with light and rain with fog middle and latter part calm we saw one Steamer and a Bark

Saturday April 5th
Strong breeze from S. Squally all day foggy with all the Barque under easy sails altered E. by N.

Sunday April 6th
Strong breeze from S. and squally the wind hauling to S.E. in the latter part quiet clear but the wind encircling the Barque under whole top sails at Sun down took in all but lower top sails

Monday April 7th
Strong breeze from S.E. and squally the wind backing to S.S.E. Still foggy in the latter part quiet moderate at Sundown became calm saw number four Bark

Tuesday April 8th
This day commences with light breeze from W. and smooth the Barque steering E. in the latter part calm

Wednesday April 9th
Light breeze from S.E. and smooth in the first part of the day in the latter part fresh breeze and rugged with rain and fog
