Remarks on Board Barque C. W. Morgan

Wednesday April 23<sup>d</sup>

The first part of this day strong breeze from S.E. in the latter part the same with rain the Barque under two lower top sails and fore sail

Thursday April 24<sup>th</sup>

Strong breeze from E.S.E. in the first part of the day middle and latter part moderate we made some sail heading to N.E.

Lat. 30=22 Long. 173=22 E.

Friday April 25<sup>th</sup>

Strong breeze from E. and rugged all this day the Bark under easy sail heading to N.E.

Saturday April 26<sup>th</sup>

The first part of this day strong breeze from E. and clear in the latter part strong breeze and squally the Barque under easy sail

Lat. 28=12 Long. 174=30 E.

Sunday April 27<sup>th</sup>

Strong breeze from E. and squally all day the ship under easy sails heading to N.E. in the first part in the latter part wore ship and head to S.

Lat. 27=30 South

Monday April 28<sup>th</sup>

Strong breeze from E.S.E. in the first of the day middle and latter part moderate the Bark under whole top sails

Tuesday April 29<sup>th</sup>

Light breeze from S.E. and light rain squalls in the first of the day in the latter part clear and pleasant all sails out

Wednesday April 30<sup>th</sup>

Light breeze from S.E. and pleasant the ship under top sails heading to S.W. Saw one vessel heading to N.W.

Thursday May 1<sup>st</sup>

Light breeze from S.E. hauling to S. and ship heading E.N.E. the weather very fine and pleasant we commence carrying again Saw four feet Backs

Lat. 29=14 Long. 174=13 E.

Friday May 2<sup>d</sup>

Fresh breeze from S.E. in the first part in the latter part the wind hauled to S. and weather very pleasant the Bark heading about S. by N.

Saturday May 3<sup>d</sup>

This day begins with calm middle and latter part light breeze from S. and pleasant the ship heading to eastward with all sail out

Sunday May 4<sup>th</sup>

Light breeze from E.S.E. and hauling back and forward with light rain squalls the Bark heading from S. to S.E.

Monday May 5<sup>th</sup>

Light wind and variable with light rain squalls all day the Bark working to eastward with all sails out

Tuesday May 6<sup>th</sup>

Fine and pleasant weather all this day and light breeze from S.E. the ship working to eastward with all sails out

Lat. 31=05 Long. 175=35 E.
