## Remarks on Board Barque C. W. Morgan

Tuesday May 20<sup>th</sup>

Fresh breeze from N.W. and clear weather the  
Bark steering S.W. in the latter part  
became rainy and heavy. Sqrally we  
took in light sails at 4 P.M. took in  
all sails but lower main top sail  
at 7 the wind hauled some but still  
rainy

Lat. 34-30 Long. 176-09 E

Wednesday May 21<sup>st</sup>

This day commenced with gale from W.  
in the first of the day the ship under  
Bare Pol middle and latter moderate  
we made sail and head to South  
Adeline Gibbs in sight

Lat. 34-50 Long. 175-33 E.

Thursday May 22<sup>d</sup>

Fresh breeze from S.E. in the first of  
the day the Bark steering S.W. with  
all sails out at 6:30 A.M. we made  
land Bay of Island we came to anchor  
at 3 P.M. in company with Adeline Gibbs

Friday May 23<sup>d</sup>

Fresh breeze from S.E. but the  
weather is very clear this day we sent  
home 1838 Pound of whale Bone and  
we broke out some oil for Coopering  
at 6:30 P.M. the Mate and part of  
the crew went on shore

Saturday May 24<sup>th</sup>

To anchor at Russell Bay of Island  
this day we broke out some oil and  
Cooper them and stowed back again  
the weather is very fine and pleasant

Sunday May 25<sup>th</sup>

Sqrally and rainy most part of the  
day wind variable but smooth part of  
the crew on shore

## of New Bedford C. F. Keith Master on whaling voyage

Monday May 26<sup>th</sup>

To anchor at Bay this day we had very fine  
weather Broke some oil to be sold and  
now the said oil lay on the deck all ready

Tuesday May 27<sup>th</sup>

To anchor at Bay today not very much  
work but Painted the Bends and got the  
oil ready to ship the weather is very  
Pleasant

Wednesday May 28<sup>th</sup>

To anchor at Russell Bay of Island  
this day we sold some oil and care credit  
on Board of the Steamer and we took  
in about 26 Barrels Pork in casks the  
weather very fine and pleasant

Thursday May 29<sup>th</sup>

To anchor at Bay of Island this day we  
have very fine weather we commenced to Paint  
Ship and we broke out some oil to sell &  
and we sold 48-28 gallons of whale oil  
to E. Ford of New Zealand

Friday May 30<sup>th</sup> Death of Capt. Chap

To anchor at Bay of Island this day we com-  
mence Braking oil forward and stowing in the  
aft whole making astowage and painting  
Ship at the same time in the latter part rain

Saturday May 31<sup>st</sup>

To anchor at Bay of Island we broke out some  
oil from forward and stowed aft part of  
Ship for trimming but is quiet hard work

Sunday June 1<sup>st</sup>

To anchor at Bay of Island this day we have  
very fine weather and pleasant the wind about  
S. and quiet light and very smooth in the  
Bay
