This day we had quiet moderate and the crew on shore on the Liberty & one boat wooding no news at this day to anchor at Mongonui

To anchor one watch on the liberty and nother getting water this day we lost one man run away

Saturday June 21st

To anchor at Mongonui now we are getting wood soon ready for sea

Sunday June 22nd

To anchor at Mongonui this day we have very fine weather

Monday June 23rd

at Mongonui still getting wood but now most of our work is down we at this time quiet ready for sea

Tuesday June 24th

Fine weather at Mongonui this time but very cold

Wednesday June 25th

This day commenced with fine weather and pleasant at A.M. we got under way from inner harbor and came out to the outer harbor and came to anchor at 3-30 P.M. we left with a fine breeze from S.W. got out by the heads and we steered E. by N. at 7-30 took in the light sails and stowed the chains

Thursday June 26th

This day begins with strong breeze from S.E. and rugged mildland latter part moderate the wind hauled to S.S.W. the Barque steering by the wind with main top gallant sail out heading from E. to S.E.

Friday June 27th

Fresh breeze from S.W. the Barque steering S.E. by E. under whole top sails in the first part we made more sail it but in the latter part strong breeze we took in light sails and steered about the same

Saturday June 28th

This day begins with strong breeze from W.N.W. the Barque steering S.E. & S. under lower top sails and courses middle part moderate we sail the wind hauled S.W. in the latter part the wind hauled again to W.N.W. but we steered about the same saw land east Cape

Sunday June 29th

Strong breeze from N. and rainy all this day the Barque under whole main topsail and lower fore topsail steering S.E. & S. at 4-30 P.M. the rain stop the hauled to about W.N.W. and wind moderate.
