

Remarks on Board Barque C. W. Morgan of New Bedford

Monday June 30th

This day begins with moderate breeze from S.W. the Barque steering S.E. & S. we made some sail in the latter part squally and rainy we took in light sail and set top sails and we steered S.E.

Lat. 41-59 Long. 177-48

Tuesday July 1st

Heavy gale from S. and rainy weather the Barque under bare Poal heading about W.

Wednesday July 2nd

Moderate gale from S. and rain squalls in the first part of the day the Barque with no sails out in the latter part we set lower main top sails and fore top mast stay sail and wind hauled to S.W.

Thursday July 3rd

Moderate gale from S.W. and wind veering to W. and the weather very squally the Barque under easy sails heading about S.

Friday July 4th

Heavy gale from S. to S.W. the Barque under bare Poal the weather very squally

Saturday July 5th

Gale from S.E.W. and squally all this day the Barque under lower main top sails and fore stay sail

Sunday July 6th

This day is the hardest gale we had the wind about S.W. with squalls and the wind blowing the hardest that I ever saw

Monday July 7th

This day commences with strong breeze from S.W. we made some sail wore ship and head to S.E. in the latter more moderate the wind hauled to W. and Barque heading to S.W. the weather very dark and gloomy over cast

Tuesday July 8th

The first part of this day strong breeze and rugged we wore away the jib middle and latter part moderate we repaired the jib the wind hauling from S.W. to W.S.W. we bent new jib

Wednesday July 9th

Strong breeze from N.W. and rugged in the first part of the day middle part more moderate but the wind hauling to S.E.W. in the latter part strong and squally the Barque under easy sails

Lat. 42-02 South

Thursday July 10th

Strong breeze from S.E.W. most all the day and rugged the Barque under easy sails working to S.W.

Friday July 11th

Moderate breeze from S.E. in the first of the day in the latter part pleasant and cold we steered S.W. by S. with all sails out

Saturday July 12th

Light breeze from E. and smooth the Barque steering S.W. by S. at 7 A.M. we made land Chatham Island at 1-30 P.M. we lower boat and Captain went on shore and came back with his wife back at 5-30
