

Remarks on Board Bark C. W. Morgan of New Bedford

Sunday July 27th

Strong breeze from W. in the first part of the day the Barque heading N.N.W. in the latter part the wind shifted to W.N.W. the Bark head off to N. at P.M. took in fore sail the Barque under easy sails

Monday July 28th

Moderate gale from W. and heavy Squalls all day Barque under lower main top sail and fore top mast stay sail at Sunset we set fore top sail

Tuesday July 29th

Heavy gale from W. all this day Bark under bare pole heading about N. and N.N.W.

Wednesday July 30th

This day begins with strong breeze from W. and Barque steered N.N.W. and made some sail for a short time and then commence to blow heavy we took in sail & lay to middle and latter part blow gale got one Boat Stoven on the beams

Thursday July 31st

Strong breeze from S.W. and heavy swell in the first part of the middle and latter part moderate we made sail & steered by the wind heading to westward Painted one boat

Friday August 1st

Light breeze from S. in the first of the day middle and latter part Calm and Painted all the Boats but at Sundown commenced raining Lat. 34-11

Saturday August 2^d

Light breeze from S. and pleasant in the first part of the middle part the wind shifted to W. and became calm

Sunday August 3^d

Light breeze from N.W. and pleasant in the first part of the day in the latter the Barque the Barque heading from N.N.E. to N.N.W. Lat. 34-43

Monday August 4th

This day begins with light breeze from S.W. middle part calm in the latter part breeze and slightly light rain the Barque working to westward

Tuesday August 5th

This day begins with calm and pleasant we took down main top sail and repaired it middle and latter part the same

Wednesday August 6th

Light breeze from S.W. in the first part of the day middle and latter part calm we repaired fore top mast stay sail at 7 P.M. commence to rain

Thursday August 7th

Strong breeze from S.E. in the first of the day the Barque steering W. in the latter part the same at Sundown took in Shorten sail

Friday August 8th

Light breeze from S. and pleasant all this day the Barque heading about W.S.W. we commenced painting the ship

Saturday August 9th

Calm in the first part in the latter part light breeze from E. and N.E.
