Sunday August 24th

Light breeze from S. and cloudy weather the under easy sails Cruising near goat Island

Monday August 25th

Light breeze from S. all day but cloudy the Barque heading to eastward

Tuesday August 26th

Light breeze from S. and hauling to S.W. in the latter part quiet - calm and we are still painting.

Wednesday August 27th

Light breeze from S. in the first part of the day in the latter part quiet - variable the Barque under easy sails

Thursday August 28th

Light breeze from S. all day and very pleasant smooth all this day the Barque under easy sails heading to eastward

Friday August 29th

Light breeze from S. and cloudy weather in the first part of the day but in the latter of the clear and pleasant the Barque heading to eastward with all sails out

Saturday August 30th

The first part light and variable wind in the latter part fresh breeze from S.E. the Barque under all sails

Lat. 31-19 Long. 175-05 W

Sunday August 31st

Light breeze from S.E. W. in the first part in the latter part strong breeze and rugged the Barque heading to S.E.

Fresh breeze from S. and squally weather in the first of the day in the latter breeze from S.E. and clear we took ship and head to S.W.

Tuesday Sept. 2^d

The weather has been calm and pleasant all this day we saw one vessel

Wednesday Sept. 3^d

Light breeze from N. and pleasant in the first part of the day the Barque steering S. by W. in the latter part fresh breeze and wind hauling to windward the Barque with all sail out

Thursday Sept. 4th

Strong breeze from W. and rugged with few rain squalls in the first of the day the Barque steering S. by W. in the latter part quiet - clear the Barque under easy sail Lat. 36-00 Long. 174-05

Friday September 5th

Light breeze from S. and heavy swell in the first part middle part calm but in the latter part light air from N. and hauling to W. the Barque heading to S.

Saturday Sept. 6th

The first part of day calm middle and latter part light breeze from S.E. the Barque heading about S.W. with all sails out

Sunday Sept. 7th

This day begins with calm in the first of the day middle and latter part breeze from N.E. W. and heavy swell from S. the Barque steering S. by W. with all sails out
