Monday Sept. 8th
Fine breeze from W. and pleasant the
wind hauling to W.N.W. the Barge
steering S. by W. to W. with all sails
out Lat. 39-54 Long. 177-00 W.

Tuesday Sept. 9th
This day begins with fresh breeze and
light squalls at 5 A.M. wind hauls
to S.W. and becomes moderate
in the middle part we made sail
in the latter part becomes pleasant
made all sails and head S. and
S. by W. Lat. 41-36 S.

Wednesday Sept. 10th
This day begins with strong breeze
from W. and hauling to S.W.
middle part blow gale but in the
latter part moderate we hoisted two
old sails and we repaired one

Thursday Sept. 11th
Fresh breeze from W. and quiet clear
in the first part the Barge steering
S.E. by S. we made all sails Bent
new main sail and jib took in
the old ones in the latter part light
breeze and pleasant at 5:30 P.M. we
saw two Sisters the Rocks

This day commences with fresh breeze
from W.W. we made all sail and stood
on to the land at 6:30 saw land
got in quiet near and lower boat
and came ashore got three Boat loads
of Potatoes in the latter part the wind
hauled to S.S.E. we left and
steered E. N.E.
