Friday Sept. 19th

Strong breeze from S.S.W. and squally weather in the first of the day we took in S.B. and repaired it and put her out again in the latter part more moderate we stered N.W. at Sun down took in sail

Saturday Sept. 20th

Strong breeze from S.S.W. in the first of the day the stered E. with whole main topsail in the latter part squally we took in top sail at 2 P.M. and furl courses at 6 P.M. took in fore top sail and Lye to

Sunday Sept. 21st

Moderate gale from S.W. and heavy squalls all this day the Barque under main lower top sails fore and main stay sail

Monday Sept. 22^d

Strong breeze from S.W. in the first part of the day middle part moderate but in the latter part strong breeze the wind hauling to W.

Tuesday Sept. 23^d

Strong breeze from W. in the first of the day the Barque heading S.S.W. under easy sails in the latter part the wind hauled to W.S.W. the weather became moderate & Pleasant we wore ship and head N.W.

Wednesday Sept. 24th

Fresh breeze from W. and W.N.W. all day the weather cloudy and partly fog by times but quiet smooth the Barque under all sails heading to S.S.W. and S.W. by S. Lat. 38.6

Bedford C. F. Keith Master on the whaling voyage

Thursday Sept. 25th

Fresh breeze from N.W. and cloudy over cast but quiet smooth the Barque heading to S.W. with all sails out at Sun down took in sail Lat. 39-06 Long. 175-14 W.

Friday Sept. 26th

Light breeze from N. and foggy in the first of the day middle and latter part clear we wore ship and head to east Barque under all sails

Saturday Sept. 27th

Strong breeze from N. and rainy in first of the day middle and latter part pleasant the wind hauled to N.W. and clear up the Barque under topsails and courses jib and spanker Lat. 39-38 Long. 173-00

Sunday Sept. 28th

This day begins with gale from N.W. and rain middle and latter part more moderate we set lower main top sail

Monday Sept. 29th

Strong breeze from N.W. and hauling to S.S.W. the Barque stered N.W. under two whole topsails and fore sail Lat. 39-04 S.

Tuesday Sept. 30th

Light breeze from S. in the first of the day we Cope off and stered N.E. in the latter part the wind hauled to E. and we still stered the same at Sun down took in sails and came to by the wind heading on the starboard tack we repaired some sail main stay sail
